







## **Project Overview**


#### **Proposed Improvements:**

- Widen, mill, and resurface the eastbound CR 512 to provide a standard merging lane east of the 108 Avenue intersection
- Regrade the eastbound swales and construct new drainage structures as required.
- Reconfigure the pedestrian ramps and crosswalks at 108 Avenue.
- Replace the eastbound and southbound signal mast arms at the CR 512 and 108
   Avenue intersection impacted by the widening.
- Provide pedestrian lighting at the CR 512 and 108 Avenue intersection
- Upgrade the eastbound signing and pavement markings as required to meet current standards



# Existing Roadway West of the 108 Avenue Intersection




# **Existing Roadway East of the 108 Avenue Intersection**



# **Construction Impacts**

# **Temporary Traffic Control Plan**

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Partial vehicular detours will be required to complete the mast arm overhead work at the CR 512 and 108 Avenue intersection.
- Partial pedestrian detours will be required to complete the Pedestrian ramps and crosswalk realignment.
- Access to properties along the corridor will be maintained at all times.


