FULL CLOSURE OF NW MILNER DRIVE FOR DRAINGE WORK TO EXTENDED THROUGH APRIL 21, 2025

St. Lucie County, as project sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) design and construct this project through Resolution No. 2022-192. FDOT is pleased to assist with completing these improvements. Please see below for more information on detours required for drainage work.

NW MILNER DRIVE BETWEEN CR 712/ MIDWAY ROAD AND NW OMEGA ROAD TO CLOSE FOR **DRAINAGE WORK**

Beginning at 5 a.m., Monday, March 3, northbound and southbound NW Milner Drive between CR 712/ Midway Road and NW Omega Road will be closed around-theclock through approximately 5 a.m. Monday, April 21 for drainage work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances arise, NW Milner Drive will open by Monday, April 28.

- Southbound NW Milner Drive motorists will be detoured via westbound CR 712/ Midway Road, southbound NW Corporate Way, eastbound NW Corporate Way and southbound NW Milner Drive.
- Northbound NW Milner Drive motorists will be detoured via westbound NW Corporate Way and northbound NW Corporate Way to CR 712/Midway Road.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen CR 712/Midway Road from a two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway. The CONTACT INFORMATION eastbound and westbound lanes of CR 712/Midway Road will be separated by a raised landscaped median.
- Construct left turn lanes in the median to allow access to adjacent side streets, properties and businesses.
- Construct 7-foot buffered bicycle lanes on both sides of CR 712/Midway Road.
- Construct a 6-foot sidewalk along the north side of CR 712/Midway Road.
- Construct a 12-foot bicycle/pedestrian path along the south side of the project.
- Install landscaping along the south side of the project.
- Upgrade drainage, signage and pavement markings.
