



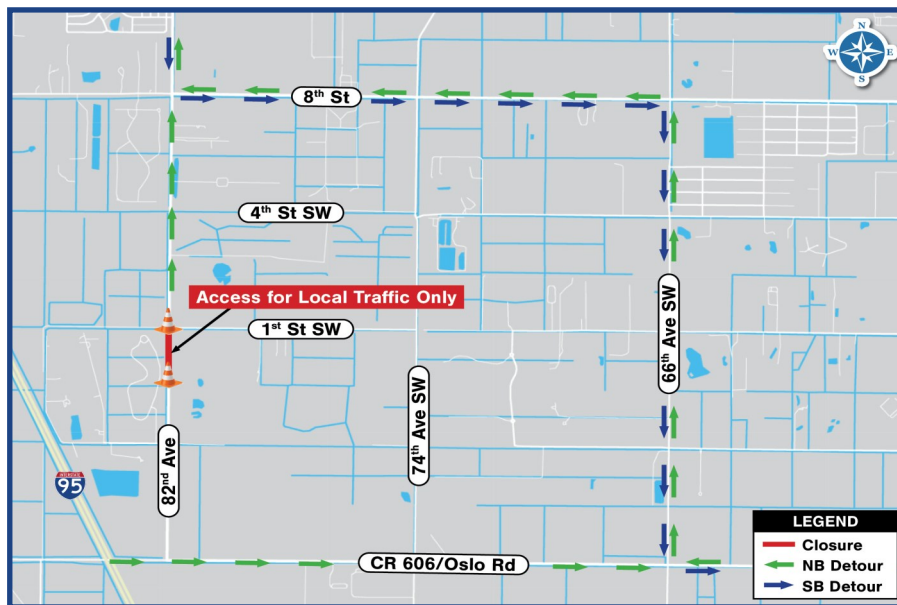

82ND AVENUE BETWEEN 1ST STREET SW AND SOUTH OF 1ST STREET SW TO CLOSE NOV. 15, 2024—FEB. 14, 2025

Northbound and southbound 82nd Avenue between 1st Street SW and 1,800 feet south of 1st Street SW will be closed from 6 a.m., Monday, Nov. 18, 2024, through 5 p.m., Friday, Feb. 14, 2025, for roadway, drainage, and utility work.

- Northbound motorists on 82nd Avenue will be detoured via CR 606/Oslo Road, 66th Avenue SW and 8th Street to 82nd Avenue.
- Southbound motorists on 82nd Avenue heading to CR 606/Oslo Road will be detoured via 8th Street and 66th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
- Local access to businesses and residential properties along 82nd Avenue between 1st Street SW and 1,800 feet south of 1st Street SW will be maintained at all times throughout construction.
