Beginning at 9 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 18, 2025, NW Milner Drive at CR 712/Midway Road will be closed around-the-clock through 5 p.m., Friday, Oct. 17, 2025, for drainage work. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, NW Milner Drive will reopen by Friday, Oct. 24, 2025. Please note NW Milner Drive will not be closed unless NW Corporate Way is opened to the Public.

- Southbound NW Milner Drive motorists will be detoured via westbound CR 712/Midway Road, southbound NW Corporate Way, eastbound NW Corporate Way and southbound NW Milner Drive.
- Northbound NW Milner Drive motorists will be detoured via westbound NW Corporate Way and northbound Corporate Way to CR 712/Midway Road.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
