

NIGHTLY CLOSURE OF CR 606/OSLO ROAD FROM 66TH AVENUE SW TO 58TH AVENUE SW EXTENDED THROUGH OCTOBER 2025

As part of the SR 9/I-95 at County Road (CR) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, eastbound and westbound traffic on CR 606/Oslo Road between 66th Avenue SW and 58th Avenue SW, will continue be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, until 6 a.m. Thursday, Oct. 30, 2025, for drainage work. This closure was implemented on Aug. 3. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, CR 606/Oslo Road between 66th Avenue SW and 58th Avenue SW will be opened by Thursday, Nov. 6, 2025.

- Westbound CR 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via 58th Avenue SW, 1st Street SW and 66th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
- Eastbound CR 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via 66th Avenue SW, 1st Street SW and 58th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
