

NIGHTLY FULL CLOSURE OF S.R. A1A NORTH CAUSEWAY BRIDGE FOR BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION DEC. 1-3 & DEC. 7-9

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, eastbound and westbound S.R. A1A North Causeway Bridge from County Road (C.R.) 605/Old Dixie Highway to the east side of the existing bridge, will be closed to traffic nightly, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, Dec. 1 through Wednesday, Dec. 3, and Sunday, Dec. 7 through Tuesday, Dec. 9, for bridge construction. Signage will be in place to direct motorists. Thursday, Dec. 4, Wednesday, Dec. 10, Thursday, Dec. 11, and Sunday, Dec. 14 through Thursday, Dec. 18 will be used as contingency nights if needed.

- Eastbound S.R. A1A motorists will be detoured via northbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 and eastbound S.R. 656/17th Street to S.R. A1A.
- Westbound S.R. A1A motorists will be detoured via northbound S.R. A1A and westbound S.R. 656/17th Street to U.S. 1/S.R. 5.
- Access for emergency and first responder vehicles will be maintained.
- The S.R. A1A North Causeway Bridge will not be closed at the same time as the S.R. 656/17th Street Bridge. Only one bridge will be closed at a time, and coordination between the closures is ongoing.
