86TH AVENUE SW AT CR 606/OSLO ROAD PERMANENTLY CLOSED FOR CUL-DE-SAC CONSTRUCTION

As part of the SR 9/I-95 at CR 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will permanently close 86th Avenue SW at CR 606/Oslo Road beginning at 5 a.m. on Friday, June 20, for the construction of a Cul-De-Sac. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. The FPL access point will be maintained.

- **Eastbound** CR 606/Oslo Road motorists to 86th Avenue SW will be detoured via south 90th Avenue SW at CR 606/ Oslo Road, and east on 13th Street to 86th Avenue SW.
- Westbound CR 606/Oslo Road motorists to 86th Avenue SW will be detoured via south 90th Avenue SW at CR 606/ Oslo Road, and east on 13th Street to 86th Avenue SW.
- Northbound 86th Avenue SW motorists will be detoured via west on 13th Street and north on 90th Avenue SW to CR 606/Oslo Road.
