

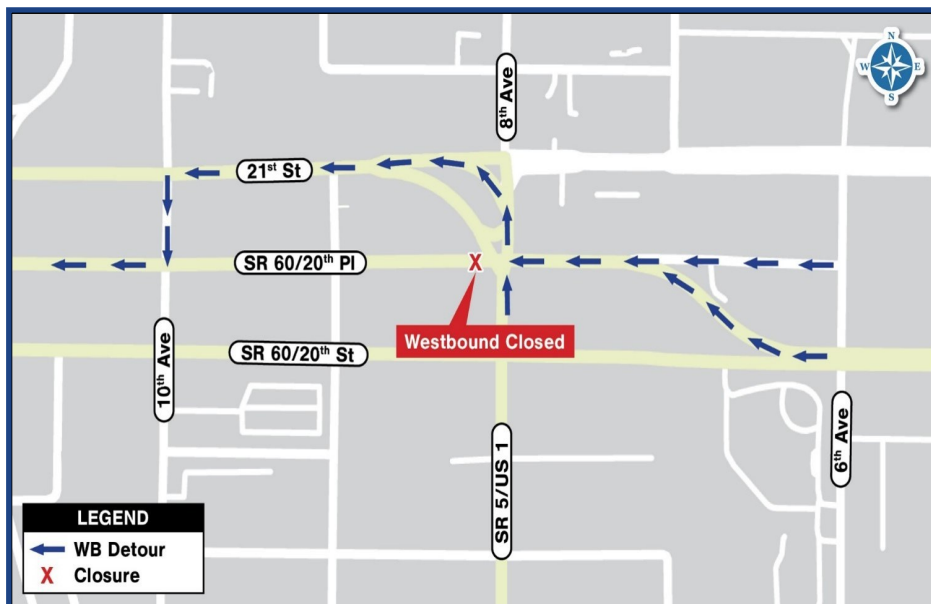

Temporary Lane Reductions and Nighttime Full Closure on Westbound SR 60/20th Place to Begin Jan. 27

- As part of the SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing project, crews will close the westbound lanes of SR 60/20th Place, between SR 5/US 1 and 10th Avenue, from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday night, Jan. 27**, to safely perform a temporary lane reduction.
- Beginning at **6 a.m., Tuesday, Jan. 28**, through 5 p.m., Friday, Feb. 7, the four-lane section of SR 60/20th Place, between SR 5/US 1 and 10th Avenue, will be reduced to two lanes. This reduction is necessary to safely perform roadway and utility work.
- To ensure the safety of motorists and crew, and to implement the temporary lane reduction, traffic will be detoured via northbound SR 5/US 1, westbound 21st Street, and southbound 10th Avenue onto SR 60/20th Place. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- Tuesday night, Jan. 28 will be used as a contingency night if needed, with lane reductions beginning the morning of Wednesday, Jan. 29.
- Westbound SR 60/ 20th Place lanes, between SR 5/US 1 and 10th Avenue will be closed, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 11, to restore the closed lanes .
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times throughout construction.
