**TRAFFIC DETOUR OF DELAND AVENUE AT SR 607/EMERSON AVENUE TO BEGIN JUNE 23**

Beginning at 8 a.m., on Monday, June 23, Deland Avenue at SR 607/Emerson Avenue will be intermittently closed, as needed, through 5 p.m., Monday, August 25, for demolition work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances arise, Deland Avenue will be closed by Tuesday, June 24.

- **Northbound** SR 607/Emerson Avenue to Deland Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Lakeland Boulevard to south on Lilyan Parkway to Deland Avenue.
- **Southbound** SR 607/Emerson Avenue to Deland Avenue motorists will be detoured via eastbound Hibiscus Road to northbound Lee Boulevard to Deland Avenue.
- Access to local residences on Deland Avenue will be maintained.
