



CR 606/OSLO ROAD EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND TRAFFIC TO BE SHIFTED THROUGH SPRING 2026

As part of the SR 9/I-95 at CR 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will implement a traffic shift beginning at 9 p.m., Sunday, July 13, through Spring 2026. The shift will occur approximately 1,500 feet west of the CR 606/Oslo Road bridge over SR 9/I-95, where eastbound and westbound traffic will be shifted onto the newly constructed westbound CR 606/Oslo Road lanes. This shift is necessary to safely perform demolition of the existing bridge, construct the new eastbound bridge, roadwork, and reconstruction activities. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, the shift will begin between Monday, July 14 and Friday, July 18.
