EASTBOUND AND WESTBOUND CR 606/OSLO ROAD TRAFFIC TO BE SHIFTED BEGINNING MARCH 24, 2025

As part of the State Road (SR) 9/I-95 at County Road (CR) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will implement a traffic shift beginning at 5 a.m. on Monday, March 24 through late 2025. The shift will occur approximately 500 feet west of the newly constructed 82nd Avenue and CR 606/Oslo Road intersection.

- **Eastbound** motorists on CR 606/Oslo Road will be shifted onto the newly constructed CR 606/Oslo Road via the right lane.
- **Westbound** motorists on CR 606/Oslo Road will be shifted onto the existing CR 606/Oslo Road via the left lane.
