### NIGHTLY CLOSURE OF C.R. 606/OSLO ROAD FROM 66<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE SW TO 58<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE SW THROUGH FEB. 26, 2026

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, C.R. 606/Oslo Road between 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW and 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW may be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, through Thursday, Feb. 26, 2026, for drainage work. Sunday, March 1 through Thursday, March 5, 2026, will be used as contingency nights if needed.

- Westbound C.R. 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via northbound 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW, westbound 1<sup>st</sup> Street SW and southbound 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW to C.R. 606/Oslo Road.
- Eastbound C.R. 606/Oslo Road motorists will be detoured via northbound 66<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW, eastbound 1<sup>st</sup> Street SW and southbound 58<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW to C.R. 606/Oslo Road.
