NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND 66TH AVENUE SW CLOSED FOR ROADWAY WORK BEGINNING FEB. 10-MARCH 10

Construction Cost: \$95.78 million Construction Start: August 2023 **Estimated Completion:** Fall 2027

- As part of the SR 9/I-95 at County Road (CR) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project, crews will implement the full closure of 66th Avenue SW between CR 606/Oslo Road and 13th Street SW, 6 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, Feb. 10 through Monday, March 10, for roadway work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances arise. 66^{th} Avenue SW will reopen by Monday, March 17.
- **Northbound** 66th Avenue SW motorists will be detoured via eastbound 17th Street SW, northbound 58th Avenue SW to CR 606/ Oslo Road.
- Southbound 66th Avenue SW motorists will be detoured via eastbound CR 606/ Oslo Road, southbound 58th Avenue SW, to westbound 17th Street SW to 66th Avenue SW.
- Local access to businesses and properties along 66th Avenue SW will be maintained.
