Overnight Closure of U-Turn Lane on eastbound 21st Street to Begin April 7, 2025

- As part of the SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing project, crews will close the eastbound U-Turn lane on 21st Street, before SR 60/ 20th Place, overnight, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, April 7 through Tuesday, April 8, to install traffic loops in the U-Turn Lane. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, the closure of the U-Turn Lane will occur from Wednesday, April 9 through Thursday, April 10.
- Eastbound motorists wanting to make a U-Turn will be detoured via southbound SR 5/US 1, eastbound SR 60/20th Place, northbound 6th Avenue, and westbound SR 60/ 20th Place to 8th Avenue.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times throughout construction.
