



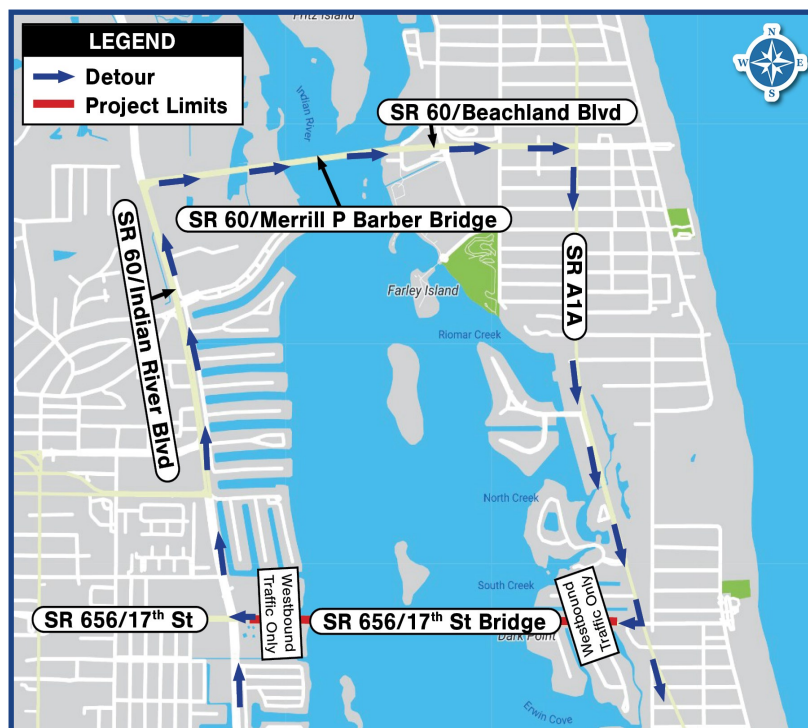

Eastbound SR 656/17th Street Bridge Detour Is Scheduled For Feb. 16-20, 2025

To ensure the safety of both the public and our crews while minimizing impacts on the traveling public, the eastbound lane of the 17th Street Bridge may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, Feb. 16 through Thursday, Feb. 20, to replace the temporary lane separators. The westbound travel lane will remain open. If weather or unforeseen circumstances occur, Sunday, Feb. 23, through Thursday, Feb. 27, will be used as contingency nights if needed.

- Eastbound SR 656/17th Street motorists will be detoured via northbound SR 60/Indian River Boulevard to westbound SR 60/Merrill P. Barber Bridge to SR A1A.
- The right lane at the intersection of the Merrill P. Barber Bridge and Indian River Boulevard has become a right-turn-only lane to help facilitate traffic. The left lane will be the thru lane for motorists heading northbound on Indian River Boulevard.
