County Road (CR) 712/Midway Road Widening Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the CR 712/Midway Road widening project from west of Jenkins Road to Selvitz Road in the City of Fort Pierce. St. Lucie County, as project sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) design and construct this project through Resolution No. 2022-192. FDOT is pleased to assist with completing these improvements. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$23.5 million **Construction Start:** February 2024 **Estimated Completion:** Summer 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen CR 712/Midway Road from a two-lane undivided roadway to a four-lane divided roadway. The eastbound and westbound lanes of CR 712/Midway Road will be separated by a raised landscaped median.
- Construct left turn lanes in the median to allow access to adjacent side streets, properties and businesses.
- Construct 7-foot buffered bicycle lanes on both sides of CR 712/Midway Road.
- Construct a 6-foot sidewalk along the north side of CR 712/Midway Road.
- Construct a 12-foot bicycle/pedestrian path along the south side of the project.
- Install landscaping along the south side of the project.
- Upgrade drainage, signage and pavement markings.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures are permitted as follows:
 - Daytime, CR 712/Midway Road, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - Nighttime, CR 712/Midway Road, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Daytime, cross streets throughout project limits, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - Nighttime, cross streets throughout project limits, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Residential and business access will be maintained.

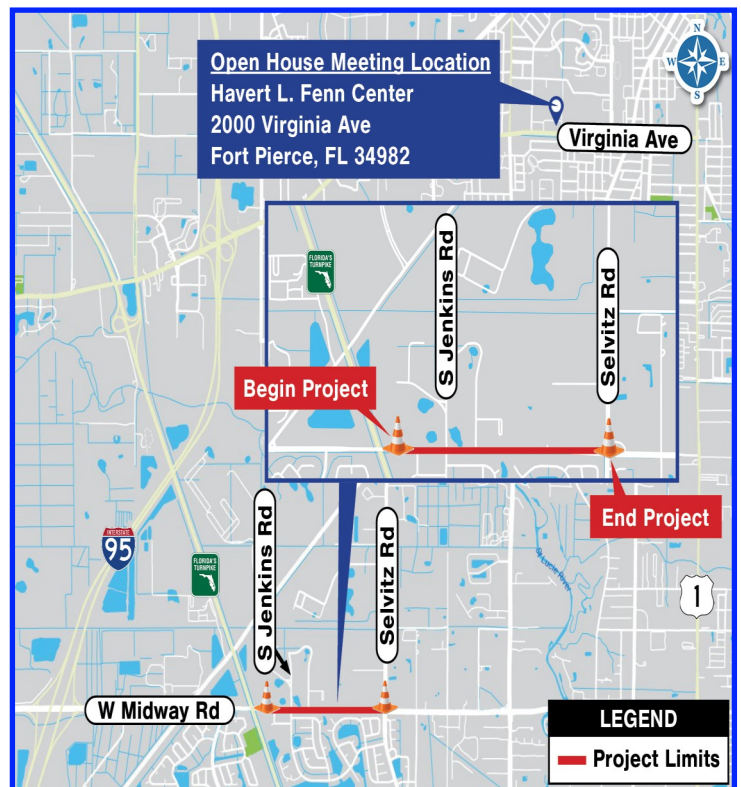
