- Single-lane closures are permitted nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- To minimize impact to the public, lane closures are not permitted on Fridays, Saturdays, holidays, or special event dates, including:
 - Vero Beach Half Marathon and Sea Turtle 2 Miler
 - · Vero Beach Boat Show
 - Vero Beach Air Show
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times
