SR 9/I-95 Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR-9/I-95 improvements within the City of Port St. Lucie. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$9.9 million

Construction Start: June 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Extend the SR 9/I-95 northbound on-ramp auxiliary lane from Gatlin Boulevard
- Extend the SR 9/I-95 southbound on-ramp auxiliary lane from St. Lucie West Boulevard
- Install a Dynamic Message Sign along northbound SR 9/I-95, south of the Gatlin Boulevard interchange to provide real time messages to motorists
- Install LED roadway lighting on SR 9/I-95 between Gatlin Boulevard and Crosstown Parkway
- Upgrade interchange signage
- Resurface SR 9/I-95 and correct cross-slopes
- Install a Dynamic Curve Warning System north of the Gatlin Boulevard interchange; the system will provide warning to motorists of excessive speed and wet pavement conditions

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- SR-9/I-95 lane and ramp closures are permitted as follows:
 - Single-lane closures are permitted nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Double-lane closures are permitted nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
 - Detours for SR 9/I-95 and the ramps are permitted nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Multiple detours are not allowed simultaneously.
