Savannas Preserve State Park SUN Trail Improvements Project

In partnership with the Florida Park Service, St. Lucie County, and the St. Lucie Transportation Planning Organization, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to assist with the construction of the newest segment of the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Network which will be located within the Savannas Preserve State Park. Construction Cost: \$10.6 million

Construction Start: July 26, 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- This segment of the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Network will be located within the Savannas Preserve State Park. The SUN Trail project improvements consist of constructing approximately 6.8 miles of 10-foot-wide accessible multi-use trail with boardwalk sections.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures are permitted on Walton Road Monday through Sunday as follows:
 - Daytime, Monday through Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
 - Nighttime, Sunday through Thursday from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.
 - Nighttime, Friday and Saturday from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
