### SR 714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SHIFT & MEDIAN CLOSURE TO BEGIN WEEK OF JULY 7

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 714/SW Martin Highway Widening Project in Martin County. Please see below for more information on detours required for roadway construction.

## TRAFFIC SHIFT ON SR 714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY FROM SW CITRUS BOULEVARD TO SW MARTIN DOWNS BOULEVARD

- Beginning the week of July 7, subject to weather, eastbound and westbound traffic on SR 714/SW Martin Highway will be shifted to their respective outside lanes to construct the median through July 2024. If the switch does not occur the week of July 7, it is anticipated to occur the week of July 14.
- SR 714/SW Martin Highway median will be closed from just west of SW Citrus Boulevard to just east of SW Leighton Farms Avenue to safely facilitate roadway construction.
- Eastbound traffic attempting to access driveways on the north side of SR 714/SW Martin Highway must U-turn on SW 42nd Ave, SW Martin Downs Boulevard, and SW Citrus Boulevard.
- Eastbound traffic attempting to leave the driveways on the northside must U-turn at SW 42nd Avenue and SW Citrus Boulevard.

#### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Widen SR 714/SW Martin Highway from a two-lane undivided rural roadway to a four-lane divided urban roadway.
- Widen the bridge over Florida's Turnpike.
- Construct seven-foot buffered bike lanes and six-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
- Realign SW Leighton Farm Avenue further west to line up with SW Deggeller Court and create a four-legged intersection.
- Install a new closed-drainage system with a retention pond.
- Install signing, signalization, and lighting upgrades.
