## SR 60 Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 60 Resurfacing Project in unincorporated Indian River County.

**Construction Cost:** \$11.19 Million

**Construction Start:** July 2024

**Estimated Completion:** Summer 2025

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Upgrading signalization and pedestrian detectors at 98th Avenue
- Constructing minor drainage improvements at various locations throughout the project corridor

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures on SR 60 are permitted at any time.

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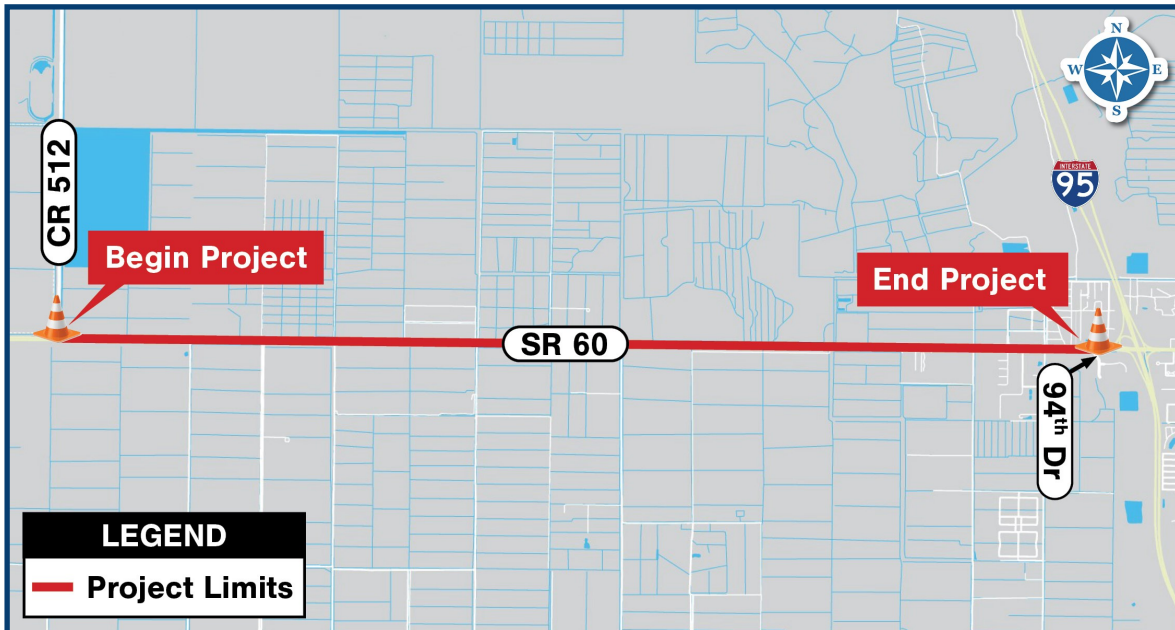
