Project Overview

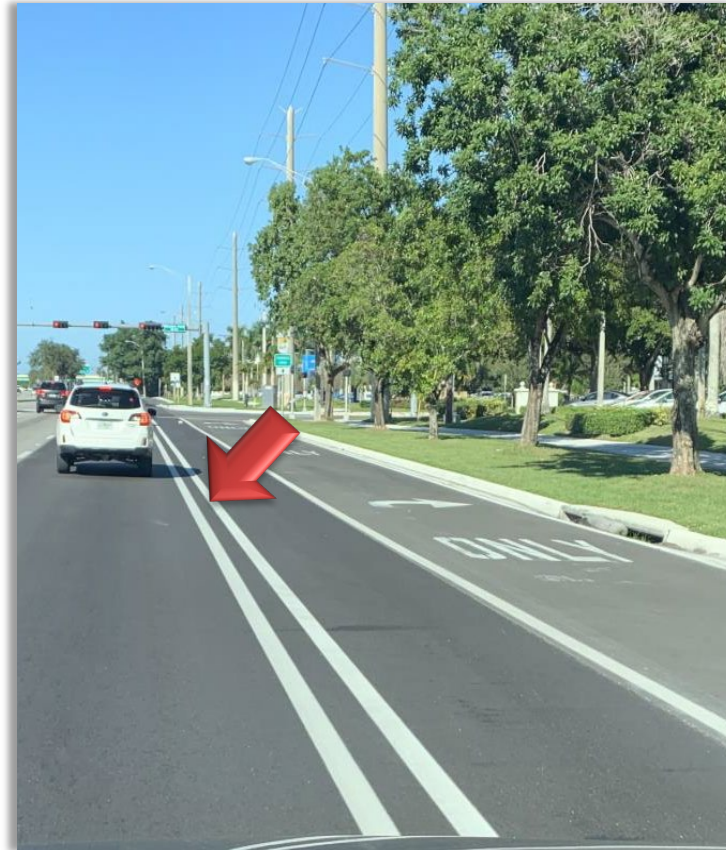
Proposed Improvements:

- Provide buffered bicycle lanes by resurfacing the existing roadway
- Replace deficient ADA pedestrian ramps
- Upgrade Guardrail connections to the existing bridge railings
- Upgrade pedestrian lighting at Juanita Ave and St. Lucie Blvd
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings

Project Length: 1.255 miles

Installation of 6' Buffered Bicycle Lanes

- Existing bike lanes widened from 4' to 6'
- A double-line buffer is provided for better delineation
- Green-colored pavement at conflict points to increase driver awareness

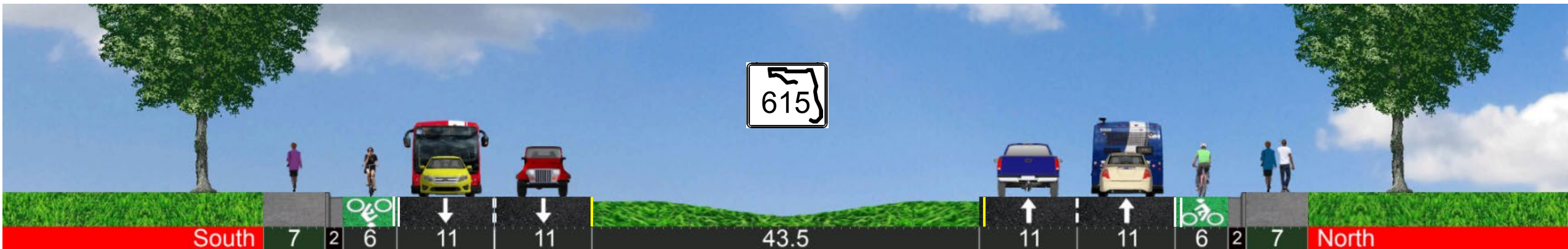

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the impacts of construction in the community
- Road will remain open, but lane closures are anticipated
- Milling and resurfacing will be performed at night
- Driveways to properties and street access will always be maintained during construction

Estimated Completion: Spring 2023

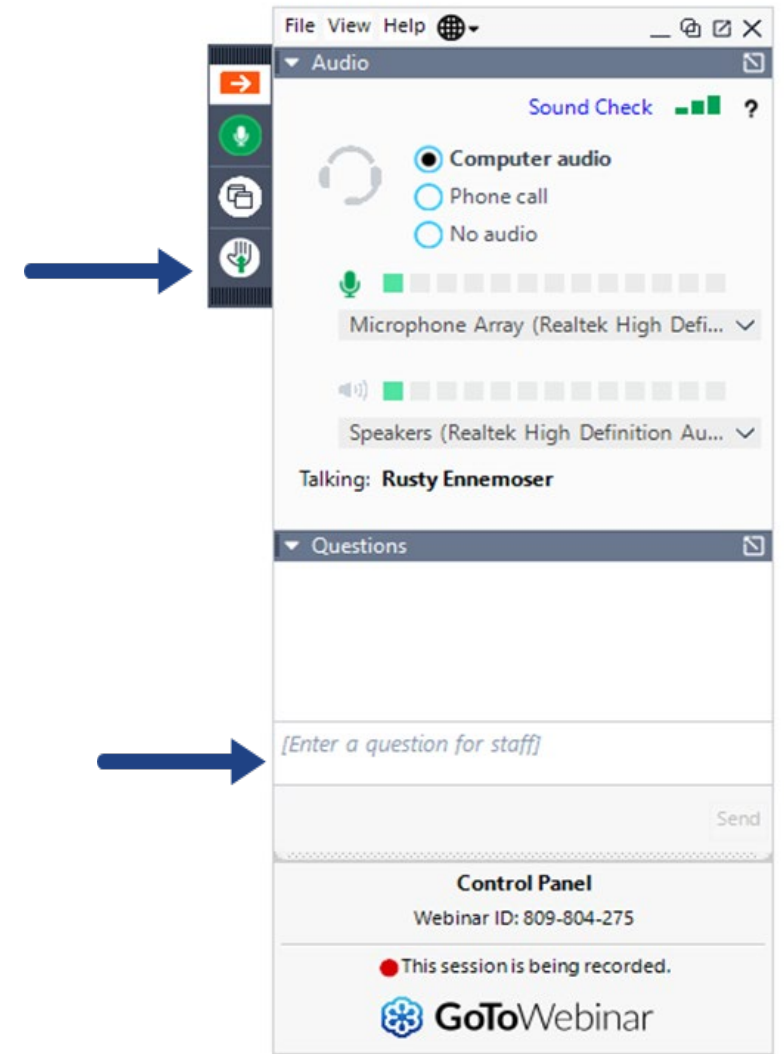

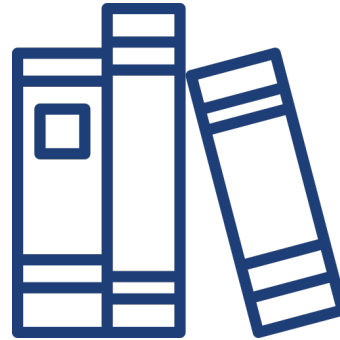

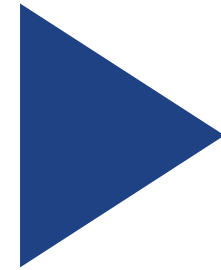
