SR 9/I-95 at CR 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project

In partnership with Indian River County, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to announce the construction of a new interchange at SR 9/I-95 and CR 606/Oslo Road. Additionally, CR 606/Oslo Road will have capacity improvements from two to four lanes from west of SR 9/I-95 to 58th Avenue per Indian River County Resolution Nos. 2017-022 and 2017-023. FDOT will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-person Construction Open House on Wednesday, August 2, 2023. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$95.78 million **Construction Start:** August 2023 **Estimated Completion:** Summer 2027

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct a new interchange with partial cloverleaf ramps at SR 9/I-95 and CR 606/Oslo Road
- Widen CR 606/Oslo Road from a two-lane to a four-lane divided roadway from west of SR 9/I-95 to SW 58th Avenue
- Install interchange ramp lighting
- Replace the existing CR 606/Oslo Road bridge over SR 9/I-95
- Install a new signalized intersection at CR 606/Oslo Road and 66th Avenue SW
- Install intersection lighting at 74th Avenue, 66th Avenue and 58th Avenue
- Realign 82nd Avenue at CR 606/Oslo Road
- Eliminate the 86th Avenue connection to CR 606/Oslo Road
- Construct 13th Street SW to connect 86th Avenue SW and 90th Avenue
- Extend the south limit of the existing noise wall on SR 9/I-95
- Replace Indian River County sanitary, water and raw water mains
- Upgrade signing, signalization, intersection lighting, bicycle lanes, and sidewalks
- Install a closed drainage system and construct three drainage ponds

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures are permitted as follows:
 - Single and double lane closures are permitted on SR 9/I-95, Sunday through Thursday night from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
 - Single lane closures on CR 606/Oslo Road, Sunday through Thursday night from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Single lane closures on 74th Avenue and 66th Avenue, Sunday through Thursday night from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Single lane closures on 58th Avenue, Sunday through Thursday night from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
 - Single lane closures on 82nd Avenue, 86th Avenue, and 90th Avenue are permitted as needed at any time.
- The regulatory speed limit on CR 606/Oslo Road from 82nd Avenue to 66th Avenue will be reduced from 55 miles per hour to 50 miles per hour for the duration of construction.
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times.
