State Road (SR) 9/I-95 at County Road (CR) 606/Oslo Road New Interchange and CR 606/Oslo Road Widening Project SR 9/I-95 at CR 606/Oslo Road, CR 606/Oslo Road from West of SR 9/I-95 to SW 58th Avenue, and CR 606/Oslo Road from East of 82nd Avenue to West of 66th Avenue Indian River County, Florida

## 66TH AVENUE SW BETWEEN CR 606/OSLO ROAD AND SOUTH OF 5TH STREET SW CLOSED FOR PAVING, AUG. 24-25

In partnership with Indian River County, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to construct a new interchange at SR 9/I-95 and CR 606/Oslo Road. Additionally, CR 606/Oslo Road will have capacity improvements from two to four lanes from west of SR 9/I-95 to 58th Avenue per Indian River County Resolution Nos. 2017-022 and 2017-023. The goal of this project is to improve the regional connectivity, safety, and resiliency of the transportation network for our local communities. 66TH AVENUE SW BETWEEN CR 606/OSLO ROAD AND SOUTH OF 5TH STREET SW CLOSED FOR PAVING

- Beginning at 6 a.m., Saturday, Aug. 24, northbound and southbound 66th Avenue SW between CR 606/Oslo Road and south of 5th Street SW, will be closed around-theclock through approximately 6 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 25, for roadway paving. Saturday, Sept. 7 through Sunday, Sept. 8, Saturday, Sept. 14 through Sunday, Sept. 15, and Saturday, Sept. 21 through Sunday, Sept. 22 will be used as contingency dates if needed.
- Westbound CR 606/Oslo Road to northbound 66th Avenue SW motorists will be detoured via 58th Avenue SW and 1st Street SW to 66th Avenue SW.
- Eastbound CR 606/Oslo Road to northbound 66th Avenue motorists will be detoured via 82nd Avenue and 8th Street to 66th Avenue SW.
- Access to Audrey's Feed and Tack will be maintained during operating hours.

#### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Construct a new interchange with partial cloverleaf ramps at SR 9/I-95 and CR 606/Oslo Road
- Widen CR 606/Oslo Road from a two-lane to a four-lane divided roadway from west of SR 9/I-95 to SW 58th Avenue
- Install interchange ramp lighting
- Replace the existing CR 606/Oslo Road bridge over SR 9/I-95
- Install a new signalized intersection at CR 606/Oslo Road and 66th Avenue SW
- Install intersection lighting at 74th Avenue, 66th Avenue and 58th Avenue
- Realign 82nd Avenue at CR 606/Oslo Road
- Eliminate the 86th Avenue connection to CR 606/Oslo Road
- Construct 13th Street SW to connect 86th Avenue SW and 90th Avenue
- Extend the south limit of the existing noise wall on SR 9/I-95
- Replace Indian River County sanitary, water and raw water mains
- Upgrade signing, signalization, intersection lighting, bicycle lanes, and sidewalks
- Install a closed drainage system and construct three drainage ponds
