SR 15/US 98 Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 15/US 98 improvements. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$20.8 million

Construction Start: August 2023

Estimated Completion: Late 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Widening the roadway shoulders to 12 feet (7 feet paved and 5 feet unpaved)
- Installing new pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures on SR 15/US 98 are permitted at any time except as follows:
 - No existing lane shall be closed at night within the project limits adjacent to residential properties
 - No existing lane shall be closed on Friday nights
 - No flagging operations are permitted at night
 - No existing side street or driveway access is permitted to be closed during construction
- No construction activities are permitted at bus stop locations during school drop off/pick up times


