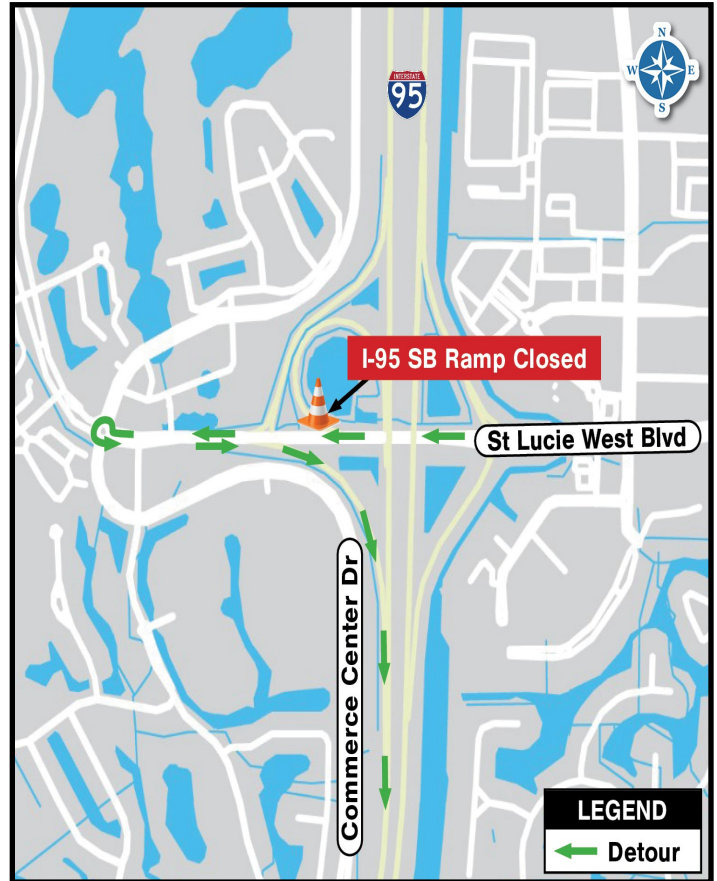

WESTBOUND ST. LUCIE WEST BOULEVARD TO SR 9/I-95 SOUTHBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP TO UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE SEPT. 7

The westbound St. Lucie West Boulevard to SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp will be closed to traffic overnight, 11 p.m., until 5 a.m., Thursday, Sept. 7 for SR 9/I-95 overhead bridge activities. Sunday, Sept. 10 through Thursday, Sept. 14 and Sunday, Sept. 17 through Thursday, Sept. 21 will be used as contingency nights if needed. During this closure, motorists will be detoured via westbound St. Lucie West Boulevard, through the roundabout at Commerce Center Drive, to eastbound St. Lucie West Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

This work is part of the St. Lucie West Boulevard widening project from Commerce Center Drive to Peacock Boulevard in the City of Port St. Lucie, St. Lucie County. Work on this project includes: constructing a new 3-lane eastbound bridge over SR 9/I-95, separated 10-feet from the existing bridge; widening St. Lucie West Boulevard to accommodate two (2) eastbound and westbound travel lanes, with a third eastbound lane between the SR-9/I-95 southbound and northbound ramps, two (2) eastbound left turn lanes at the SR 9/I-95 northbound on ramp, two (2) westbound right turn lanes at the SR 9/I-95 northbound on ramp; reconstructing/widening the SR 9/I-95 ramps; connecting the existing St. Lucie West Boulevard roadway to the new eastbound bridge from the east and west directions; constructing 7-foot buffered bike lanes/paved shoulder and 5-foot to 6-foot wide sidewalks on both sides of the roadway; constructing a 22-foot to 40-foot lane-line to lane-line curbed median with curb and gutter; installing fencing retrofits on the north side of the existing bridge, and new railings on the eastbound bridge; and, installing new traffic signals with enhanced synchronization and timing at SR 9/I-95 ramps.
