122ND AVENUE SW AT SR 60 CLOSED FOR DRAINAGE WORK, SEPT. 3-6

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 60 Resurfacing Project in unincorporated Indian River County. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure within our communities. Please see below for information on detours required for drainage work.

Construction Cost: \$11.19 Million

Construction Start: July 13, 2024

Estimated Completion: Summer 2025

DRAINAGE WORK ON 122ND AVENUE SW AT SR 60

- 122nd Avenue SW at SR 60 will be closed daily, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Tuesday, Sept. 3 through Friday, Sept. 6, for drainage work. Monday, Sept. 9 through Friday, Sept. 13 will be used as contingency dates if needed.
- Eastbound and westbound SR 60 motorists to 122nd Avenue SW will be detoured via 130th Avenue and Oslo Road Extension/9th Street SW to 122nd Avenue SW.
- Northbound 122nd Avenue SW to SR 60 motorists will be detoured via Oslo Road Extension/9th Street SW and 130th Avenue to SR 60.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Upgrading signalization and pedestrian detectors at 98th Avenue
- Constructing minor drainage improvements at various locations throughout the project corridor

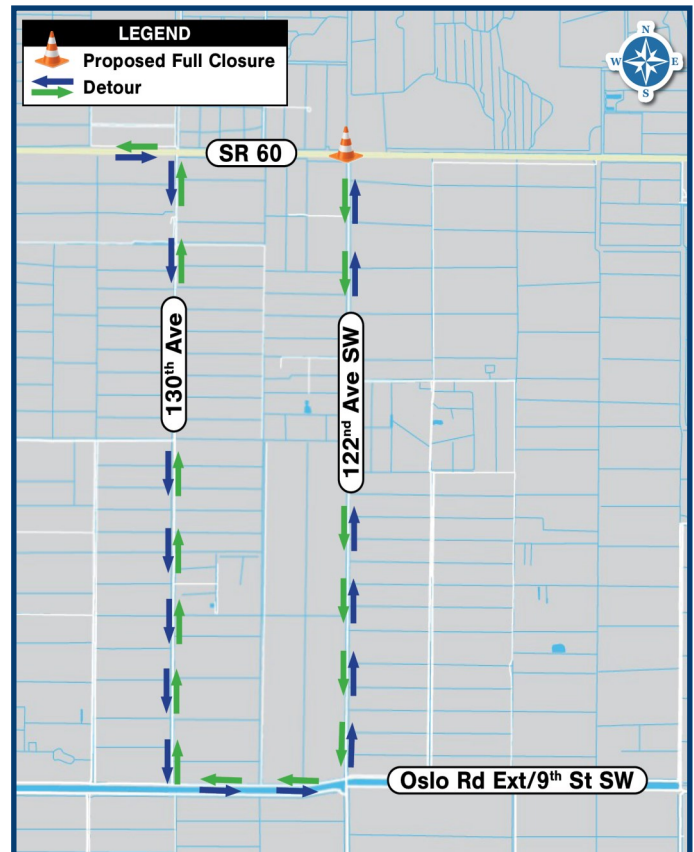
