SR 656/17th Street Bridge May Undergo Nighttime Full Closures for Concrete Deck Pours, Aug. 18-Sept. 5

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 656/17th Street East End of Bridge Rehabilitation Project in the City of Vero Beach. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. Please see below for information on detours required for concrete deck pours.

Construction Cost: \$22.3 million

Construction Start: September 5, 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2028

CONCRETE DECK POURS ON SR 656/17TH STREET BETWEEN SR A1A AND INDIAN RIVER BOULEVARD

- The SR 656/17th Street Bridge between SR A1A and Indian River Boulevard, may be closed nightly as needed, 11:30 p.m. through approximately 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Sunday, Aug. 18 through Thursday, Sept. 5, for concrete deck pours. Sunday, Sept. 8 through Thursday, Sept. 12 will be used as contingency nights if needed.
- Westbound motorists will be detoured via SR A1A and Beachland Boulevard to Indian River Boulevard.
- Eastbound motorists will be detoured via Indian River Boulevard and Beachland Boulevard to SR A1A.
- Local traffic only will be allowed on the east side of the bridge.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacement of the eastern 400 feet of the existing bridge.
- Sealing the full length of the existing bridge deck surface.
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings.
