Kings Highway/State Road 713 is being widened from south of State Road 70 to north of the I-95 overpass in the City of Ft. Pierce and unincorporated St. Lucie County. Please see below for information on detours required to complete drainage installation.

DRAINAGE INSTALLATION BETWEEN PRUITT RESEARCH ROAD AND CROSSROADS PARKWAY

- Beginning at 8 p.m. Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, Kings Highway between Pruitt Research Road and Crossroads Parkway, will be closed around-the-clock through approximately 6 a.m. Monday, Sept. 13, 2021, for drainage installation across the roadway
- Detour routes will be marked along Graham Road, Jenkins Road, Okeechobee Road, and Crossroads Parkway, as noted on the detour map provided

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstructing existing two-lane undivided
 Kings Highway with a newly constructed four-lane divided roadway
- Relocating Canal No. 40 and Canal No. 32E to accommodate widening to the west
- Realigning Kings Highway at the intersection with Okeechobee Road to improve the existing connection to Florida's Turnpike
- Replacing existing culverts/swales and installing a closed drainage system and retention ponds
- Installing a new highway lighting system
- Upgrading signalization with vehicle detection devices and ITS cameras
