#### SW Citrus Boulevard at SR-714/SW Martin Highway to Undergo Full Nighttime Closure, Sep 5 - 29

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR-714/SW Martin Highway Widening Project in Martin County. Please see below for more information on detours required for roadway construction and pipe installation work.

**Construction Cost:** \$21,345,976

**Construction Start:** August 6, 2021

**Anticipated Completion:** Fall 2024

#### ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION WORK ACROSS SW CITRUS BOULEVARD AT SR-714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY

- SW Citrus Boulevard at SR-714/SW Martin Highway, may be closed to traffic overnight, from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m., Friday, Sept. 8 through Friday, Sept. 29 for roadway construction. Saturday, Sept. 30 through Friday, Oct. 6 will be used as contingency nights if needed.
- Eastbound SR-714/SW Martin Highway to southbound SW Citrus Boulevard motorists will be detoured via SW Leighton Farm Avenue and SW Moore Street to SW Citrus Boulevard.
- Southbound SW Citrus Boulevard motorists continuing south on the roadway will be detoured via SR-714/SW Martin Highway, SW Leighton Farm Avenue, and SW Moore Street to SW Citrus Boulevard.
- Northbound SW Citrus Boulevard motorists to SR-714/SW Martin Highway will be detoured via SW Moore Street and SW Leighton Farm Avenue to SR-714/SW Martin Highway.
- Northbound SW Citrus Boulevard motorists continuing north on the roadway will be detoured via SW Moore Street, SW Leighton Farm Avenue and SR-714/SW Martin Highway to SW Citrus Boulevard.
- Local traffic between SR-714/SW Martin Highway and SW Moore Street will be escorted through the work zone by project personnel and off-duty police officers.

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen SR-714/SW Martin Highway from a two-lane undivided rural roadway to a four-lane divided urban roadway.
- Widen the bridge over Florida's Turnpike.
- Construct seven-foot buffered bike lanes and six-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
- Realign SW Leighton Farm Avenue further west to line up with SW Deggeller Court and create a four-legged intersection.
- Install a new closed-drainage system with a retention pond.
- Install signing, signalization, and lighting upgrades.
