SR 714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SHIFT & MEDIAN CLOSURE TO BEGIN WEEK OF OCT. 9 WEATHER PERMITTING

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information for the SR 714/SW Martin Highway Widening Project in Martin County. Please see below for more information on detours required for roadway construction.

Construction Cost: \$21,345,976

Construction Start: August 6, 2021

Anticipated Completion: Fall 2024

TRAFFIC SHIFT ON SR 714/SW MARTIN HIGHWAY FROM SW CITRUS BOULEVARD TO SW LEIGHTON FARMS AVENUE

- Beginning Monday, October 9, 2023, eastbound traffic on State Road 714/SW Martin Highway just west of SW Citrus Boulevard will be shifted south to the newly constructed roadway to allow for westbound road construction through February 2024.
- SR 714/SW Martin Highway median will be closed from just west of SW Citrus Boulevard to just east of SW Leighton Farms Avenue to safely facilitate roadway construction.
- Eastbound traffic attempting to access driveways on the north side of SR 714 will be required to make U-turns on SW 42nd Ave, Martin Downs Highway, and SW Citrus Boulevard.
- Eastbound traffic attempting to leave the driveways on the northside will be required to make U-turns at SW 42nd avenue and SW Citrus Boulevard.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen SR 714/SW Martin Highway from a two-lane undivided rural roadway to a four-lane divided urban roadway.
- Widen the bridge over Florida's Turnpike.
- Construct seven-foot buffered bike lanes and six-foot sidewalks on both sides of the roadway.
- Realign SW Leighton Farm Avenue further west to line up with SW Deggeller Court and create a four-legged intersection.
- Install a new closed-drainage system with a retention pond.
- Install signing, signalization, and lighting upgrades.
