#### PROJECT PURPOSE

To enhance safety by milling and resurfacing existing pavement and applying high friction surface treatment to reduce vehicles running off the road.

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing existing roadway
- Overlay ramp with high friction surface treatment to improve safety
- Widen existing left shoulder from 2' paved to 4' paved
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings to enhance visibility
- Upgrade existing lighting to LED fixtures to improve visibility

#### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- NB Ramp closures will be permitted as follows:
  - Nighttime, Sunday through Thursday, 8:00 am to 6:00 am
- Additional information about lane closures, detours, and pedestrian impacts will be provided in the weekly

#### CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Anticipated Construction Start: **Winter 2025**
- Anticipated Construction Completion: **Spring 2026**
- Estimated Construction Cost: **\$524,000**

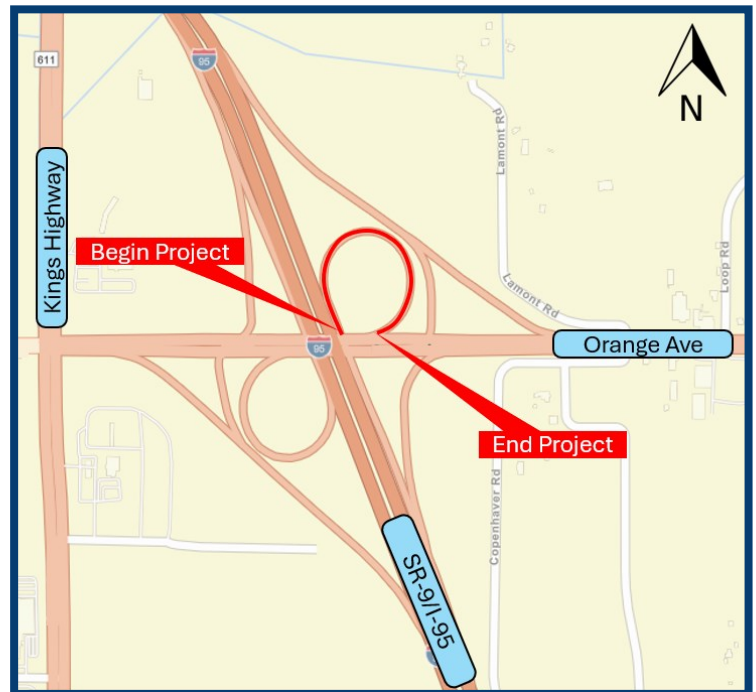
