Existing Roadway

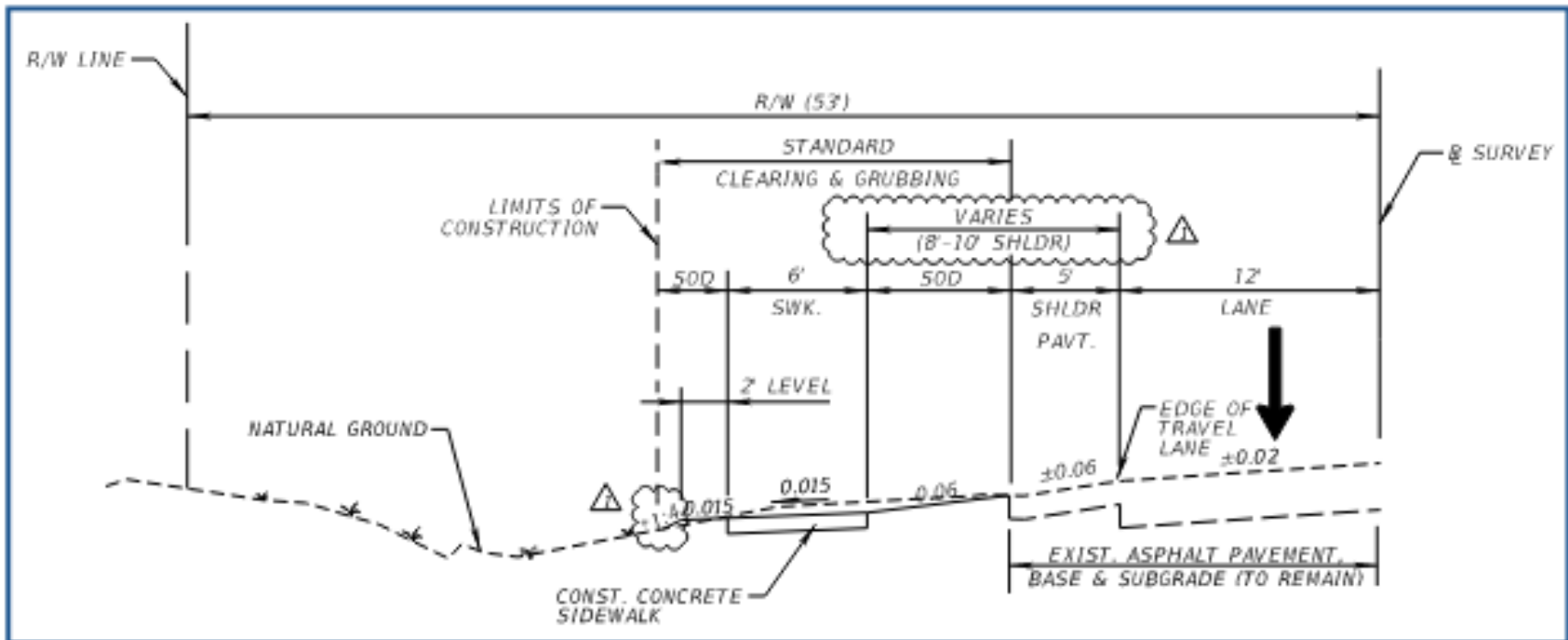
Existing Plans

2005 – Roadway milling and resurfacing including shoulder construction and shoreline stabilization with rubble rip-rap



Existing Plans

2019 – Southbound sidewalk construction



Existing Conditions

- Two-lane and three-lane undivided roadway segments with turn lanes
- Two-lane divided (landscaped raised median) roadway segments with turn lanes
- Posted Speed: 40 mph to 45 mph



Existing Conditions

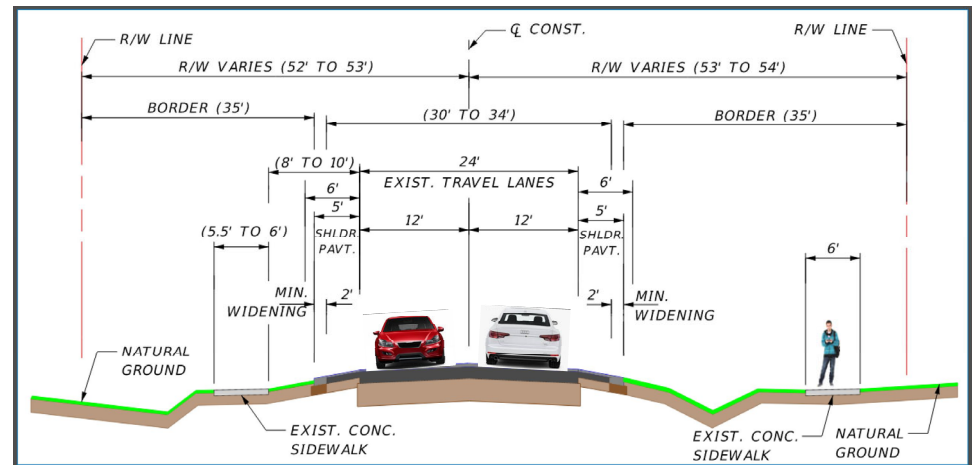
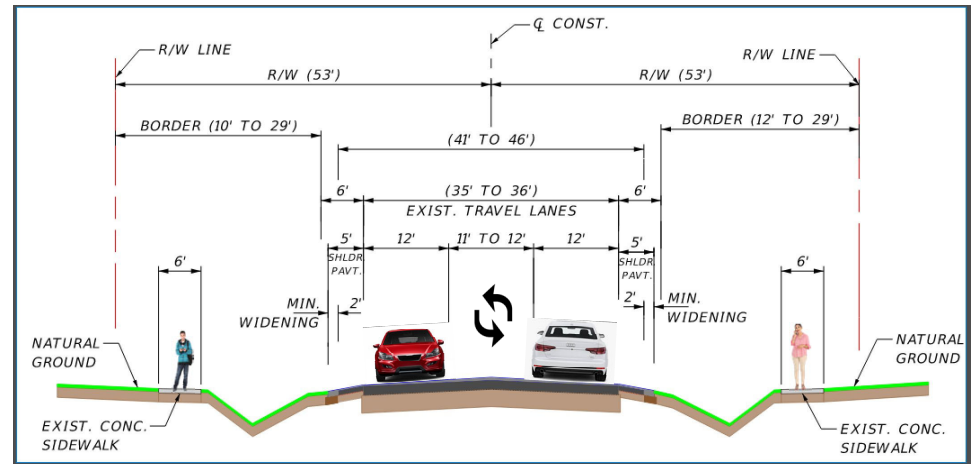
- Lane width: 11 feet to 12 feet
- Shoulder width: 4 feet to 5 feet
- Sidewalk width: 6 feet
- Roadside drainage swales
- Midblock crosswalks
- Single-lane roundabout at north end



Proposed Improvements

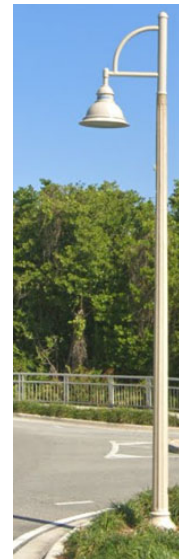
Proposed Improvements

- Repave and restripe existing roadway
- Minor shoulder widening to provide 5-foot paved shoulders
- Regrade existing drainage swales and correct localized ponding
- Ocean View Condominiums drainage outfall to Intracoastal Waterway
- Replace and upgrade existing curb ramps
- Replace existing signing and pavement markings



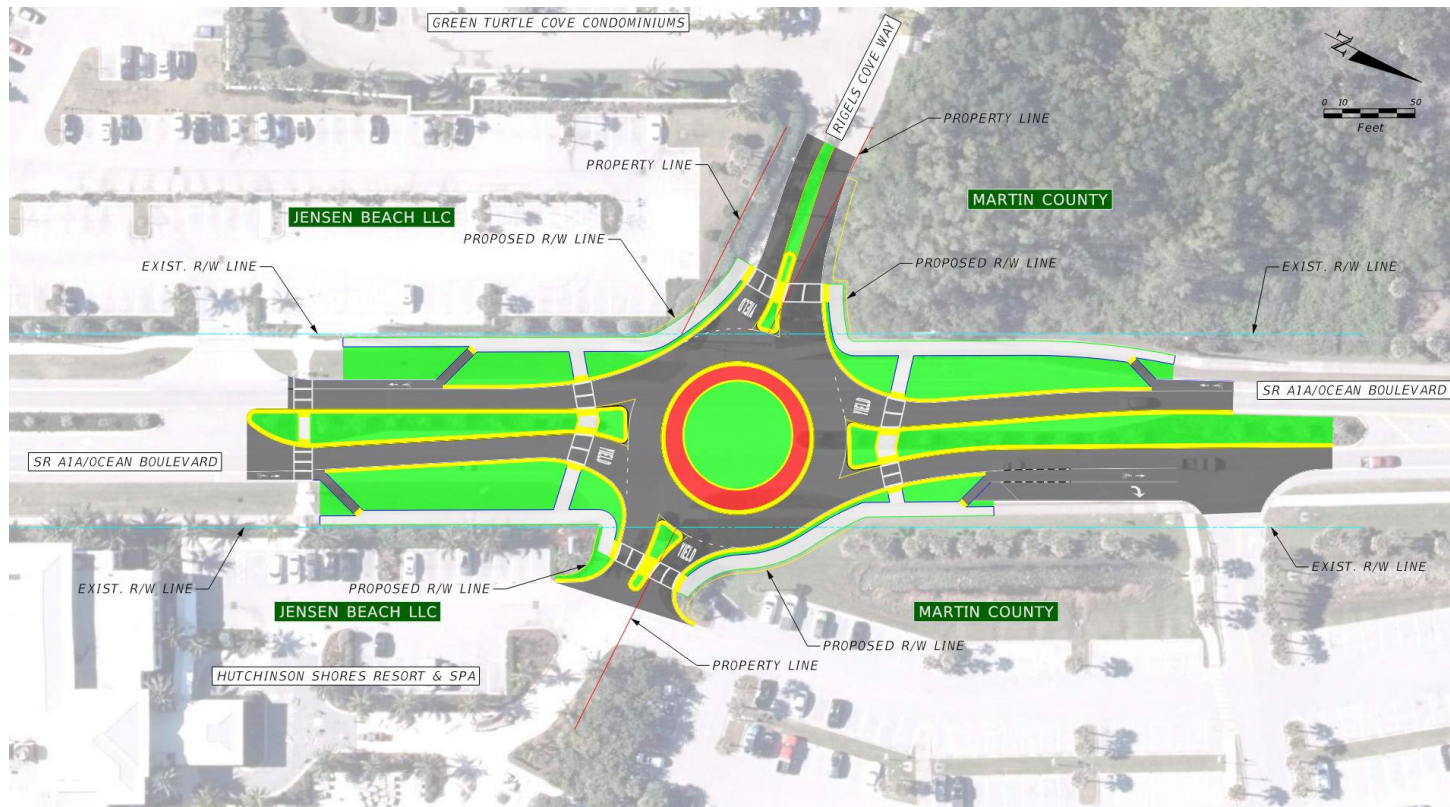
Proposed Improvements

- Lighting improvements from Hutchinson Shores Resort to Jensen Beach Causeway Boulevard
- Lighting improvements at pedestrian midblock crossings
- Upgrade/retrofit lighting at existing roundabout
- Raised travel lane rumble strips for existing and proposed roundabouts
- Flashing beacons at pedestrian midblock crossings
- Speed feedback signs



Proposed Improvements

New single-lane Roundabout at SR A1A/Rigels Cove Way (Green Turtle Cove) intersection



Maintenance of Traffic

Maintenance of Traffic

- Work will be done in phases to reduce construction impacts
- Number of existing lanes will be maintained except during permitted lane closures
- A travel lane will only be closed while work is being performed
- All existing lanes of traffic will be open during inactive work periods



Maintenance of Traffic

- Vehicular detours are not expected
- Pedestrian detours may be required for sidewalk closures
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times
- Construction will not be performed at night during sea turtle nesting season

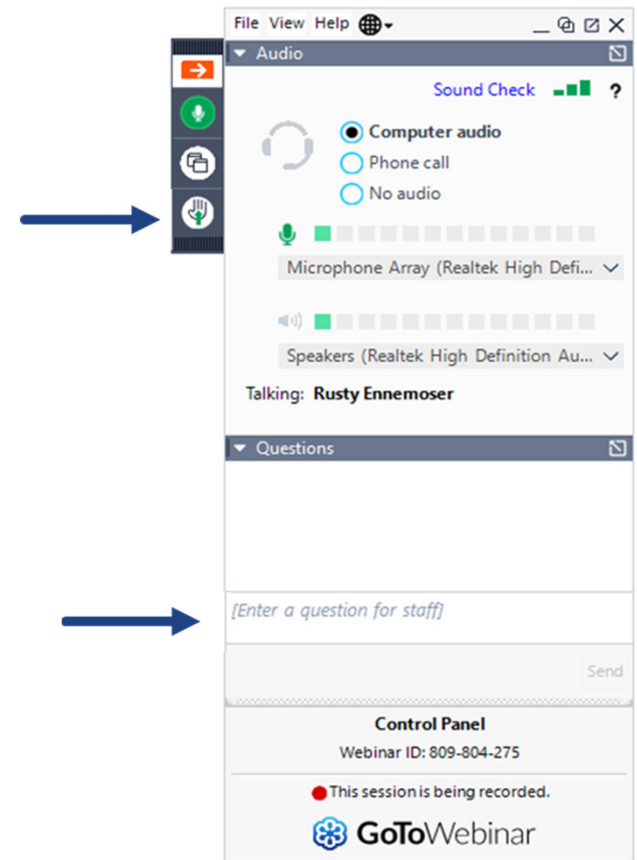

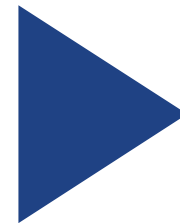
