SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing Project in the City of Vero Beach. The project limits are on SR 5/US 1 from north of 12th Street to north of SR 60/20th Place in the City of Vero Beach. This project aims to enhance safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure in our communities. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$3,198,986

Construction Start: November 2024

Estimated Completion: Summer 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to enhance safety and long-term resiliency
- Installing four-foot bicycle lanes
- Reconstructing existing sidewalk curb ramps to enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians
- Upgrading pedestrian countdown signal features with newer technology at 15th Place, SR 60/20th Street, and SR 60/20th Place to enhance pedestrian safety and functionality
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings to improve safety, functionality, and traffic operations

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures on SR 5/US 1 are permitted nightly, Sunday through Thursday during the following timeframes:
 - 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. within 600 feet of a signalized intersection
 - 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. outside of 600 feet from a signalized intersection
- Double-lane closures on westbound SR 60/20th Place at the SR 5/US 1 intersection and the southbound outside lane of SR 5/US 1 north of SR 60/20th Place are permitted around-the-clock and shall not exceed 14 calendar days; advanced notice will be provided
- The speed limit on westbound SR 60/20th Place will be reduced from 40 mph to 35 mph during Phase 1 of construction; 40 mph for all other phases
- Sections of the sidewalk will be closed one side at a time to maintain pedestrian traffic but will not exceed two continuous blocks
- Access to and from bus stops will be maintained. In the event that access cannot be maintained, advanced notice will be provided
- Business, pedestrian and residential access will be maintained at all times throughout construction

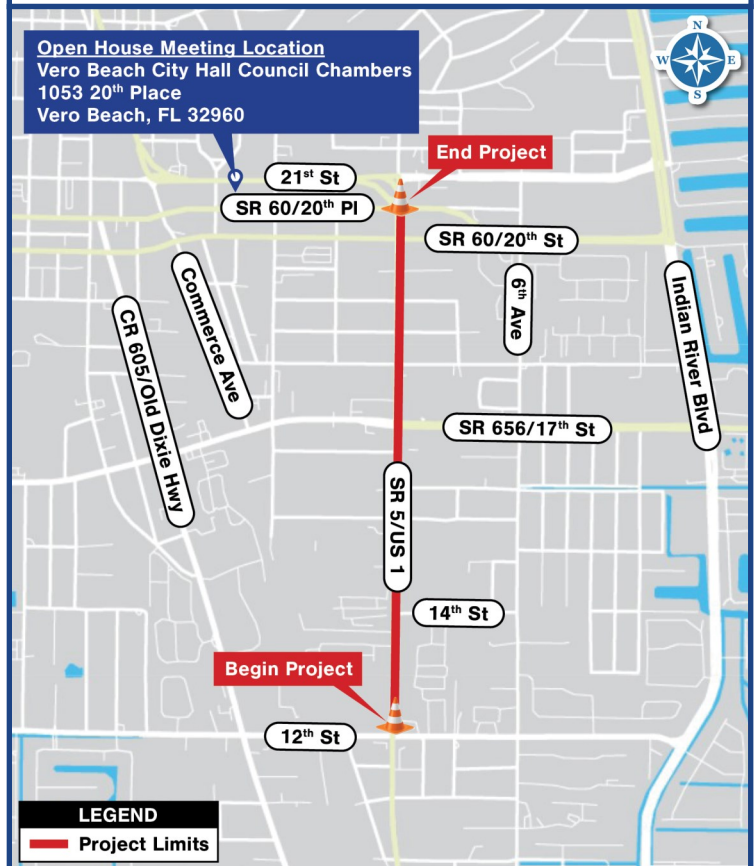
