Construction Cost: \$4.8 million

Construction Start: January 2024

Estimated Completion: Fall 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct a westbound left turn lane on SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard at SW Tommy Clements Street.
- Construct ten-foot paved shoulders in each direction of SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard.
- Construct a retaining wall.
- Upgrade drainage, signage and pavement markings.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures on SR 710/SW Warfield Boulevard are permitted Monday through Sunday, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Residential and business access will be maintained.

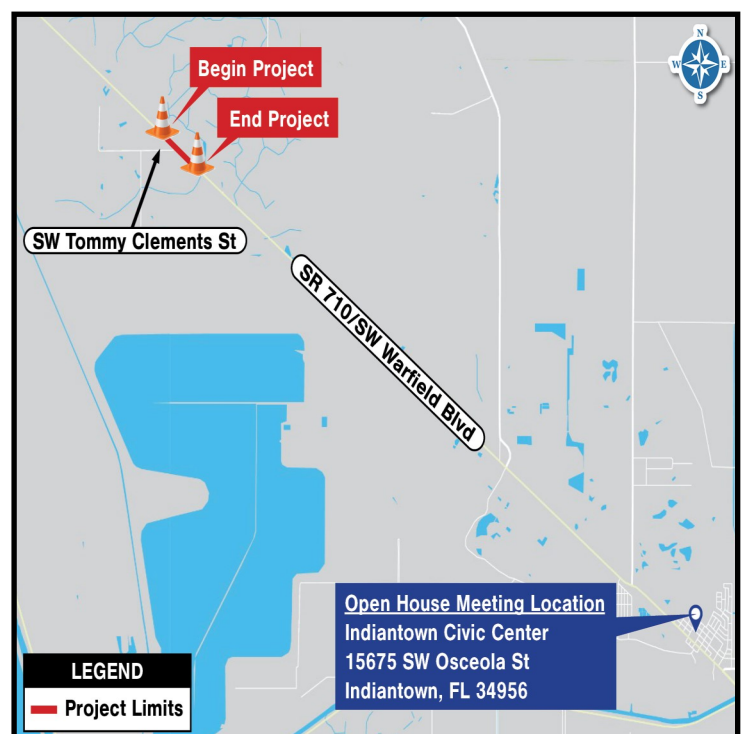
