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

#### **Scope / Proposed Improvements**

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- Repaying and restriping the existing roadway
- Construct new sidewalk & replace damaged sections
- Bus stop improvements
- Reconstruct left turn lane to Sebastian Blvd. (CR 512 Westbound)
- Upgrading the existing crosswalks, curb ramps, detectable warnings, and sidewalk to current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Enhance bike lane safety and visibility
- Correct drainage deficiencies to avoid water ponding
  - . Replace existing drainage inlets
- Ground mounted and advanced multi-post street name signs
- Pedestrian signal crossings at CR 512
  - Signal heads upgraded to countdown type
- . Retrofit intersection lighting
  - Four new light poles at Main St.





- Milling and Resurfacing.
- ADA upgrades.
- Retrofit intersection lighting.














#### **Maintenance of Traffic**

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- Work will be scheduled in phases to reduce effects of construction on the community
- Temporary lane closures will take place during non-peak hours to reduce impact to the traveling public
- Access to businesses and private properties will be maintained at all times during construction

**Estimated Completion:** Summer 2024


Estimated Construction Cost: \$2.6 million


