Project Location

Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project: State Road (SR) 60 from west of County Road (CR) 512 to west of 94th Drive



Project Overview

Proposed Improvements:

- Repave and restripe the existing roadway within the project limits
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings
- Upgrade signalization at 98th Avenue
- Improve drainage as needed

Project Length: 7.401 miles

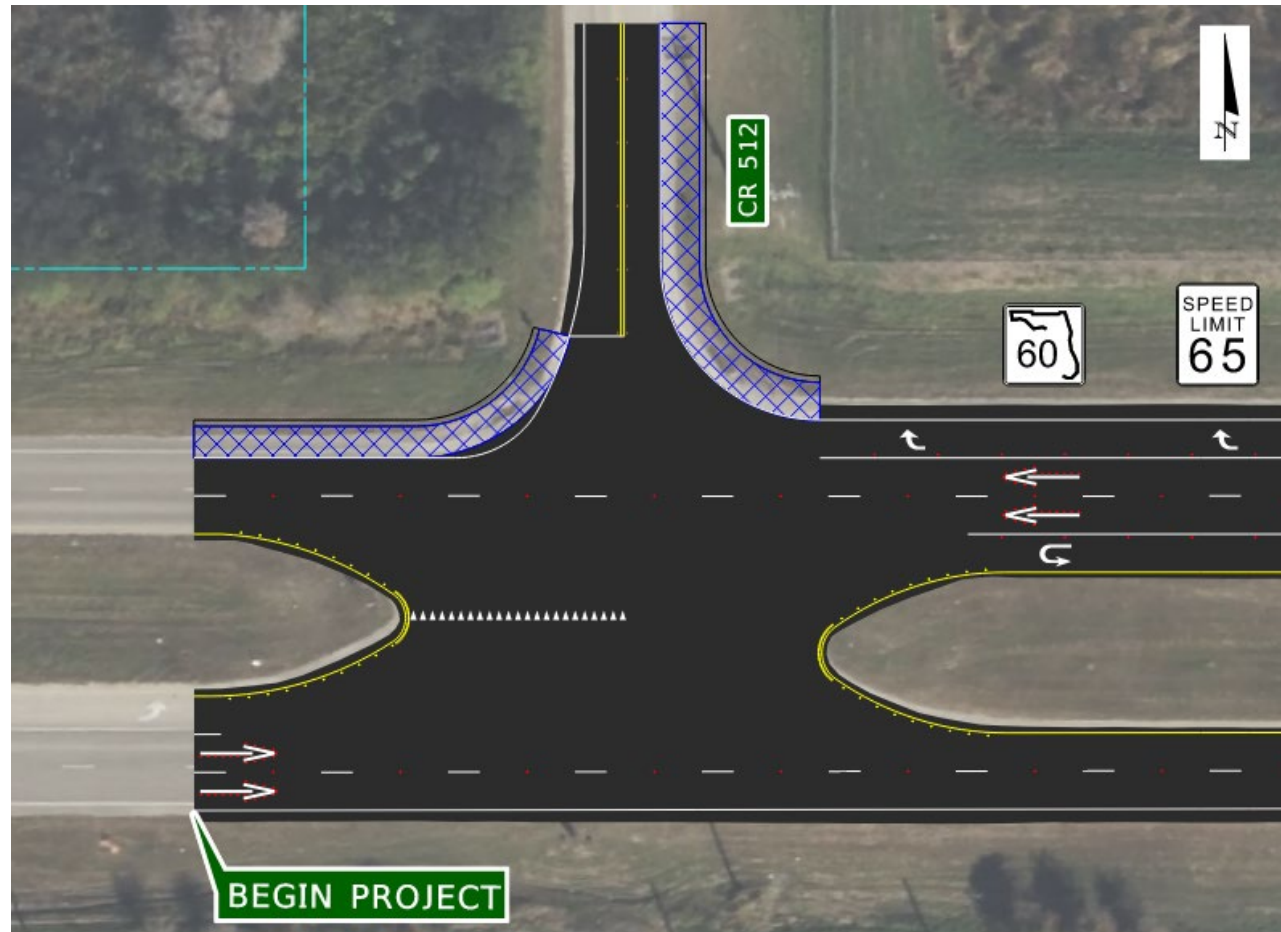

Proposed Improvements:

- Travel lane and shoulder widths will remain the same as existing condition

CR 512 Avenue Intersection

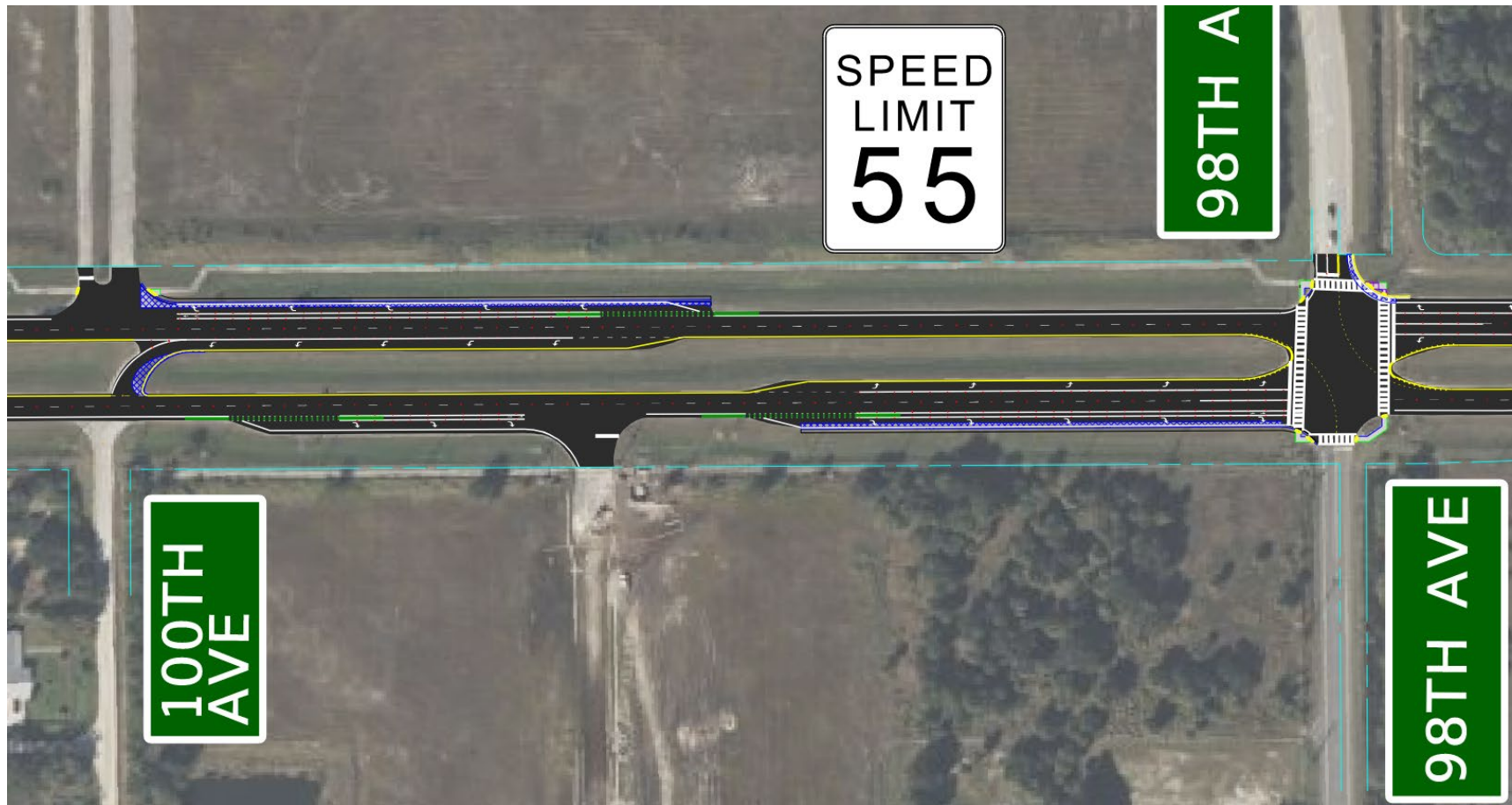


98th Avenue Intersection



- EB SR 60 right turn lane minor widening
- Replace existing pedestrian ramps to meet ADA

Signing and Pavement Marking Improvements



- Replacement of single and multi post signs
- Audio Vibratory Treatment (AVT)
- Upgrade pavement markings including green colored keyhole bike lanes

98th Avenue Signalization Improvements



- Signalization detection upgrade to Video at 98th Avenue N. intersection
- Add retroreflective backplates to improve signal head visibility



- Replacement of pedestrian push-buttons and signal heads to meet ADA

Maintenance of Traffic

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Temporary lane closures will be required during daytime hours
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
- No detours are necessary. Lane closures will be limited to one travel lane at a time

Estimated Construction Cost: \$11.3 Million*

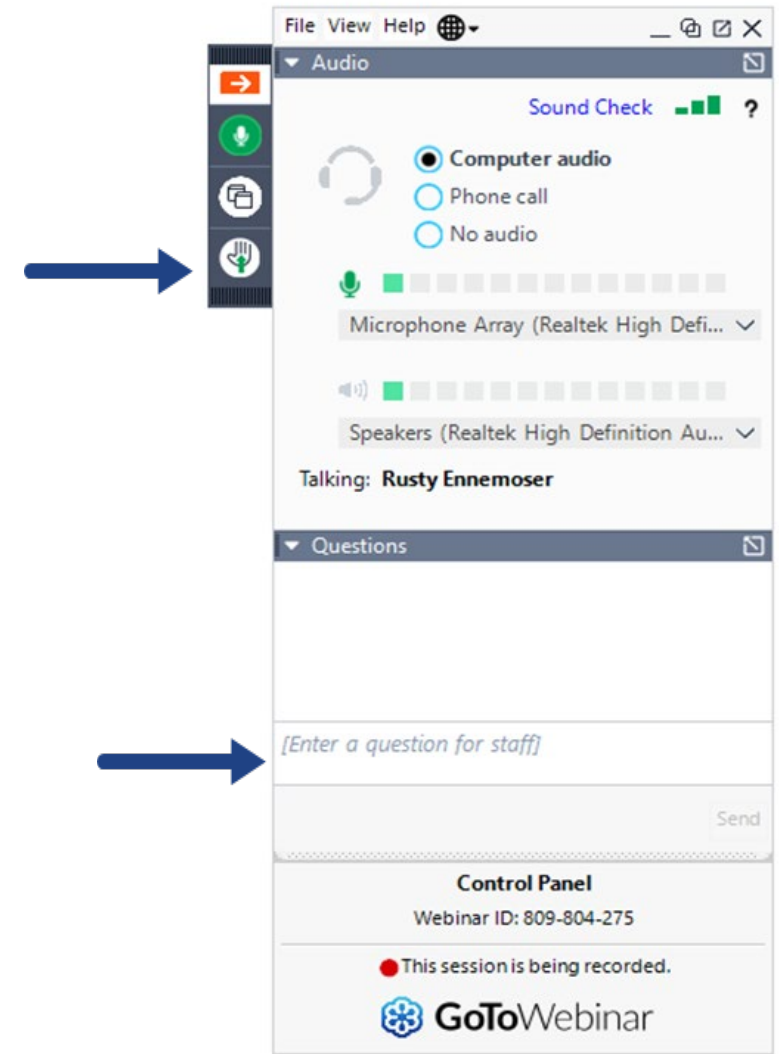

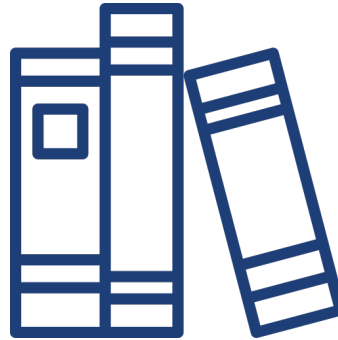

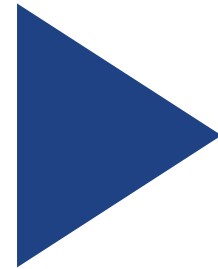
