SR 93/I-75 ALLIGATOR ALLEY RESURFACING, RESTORATION, AND REHABILITATION (RRR) PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide the community with information about the SR 93/I-75 Alligator Alley Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project with limits from the Broward/Collier County Line to Mile Post 31.261 in Broward County. This project aims to enhance the safety, resilience, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$27,933,983

Construction Start: September 2024

Estimated Completion: Summer 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Installing guardrail within the project limits to enhance safety
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings within the project limits to enhance nighttime visibility

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures along SR 93/I-75 are permitted Sundays at 9:00 p.m. until Fridays at 6:00 p.m.
- Extended single lane closures at bridge locations are permitted, as needed, for guardrail replacement.
- Single ramp closures at the Snake Road interchange will be required for milling and resurfacing the off and on ramps. This operation will be scheduled from 9:00 p.m. until 11:00 a.m. on Friday and/or Saturday nights. Detours will be in place to direct motorists and advanced notice will be provided.
- Access to rest areas and boat ramps may be temporarily closed, as needed, during nighttime paving operations. Closures will be restricted to one ramp at a time.


