I-95 AT BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD — FALL 2025 PROJECT UPDATE

Friday, Nov. 14, 2025 marks day 96 of 1057, with work 8% completed. Crews are working day and night to prepare for the first phase of bridge and ramp widening. Additional information, progress photos and videos can be found on the [project page](#).

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Traffic railing demolition on the south side of the Boynton Beach Boulevard bridge over I-95
- Temporary lighting and signalization installation
- Clearing, grubbing, and tree relocation along the I-95 ramps
- Excavation work throughout the project limits
- Test pile and pile driving operations on both the north and south sides of the interchange
- Directional boring for ITS installation

UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Traffic will be shifted to begin bridge demolition on the south side of Boynton Beach Boulevard over I-95
- I-95 ramp widening operations and reconstruction will be ongoing through the winter season

ANTICIPATED LANE, RAMP AND I-95 CLOSURES

- **I-95 Traffic Impacts:** One lane of I-95 may be closed in each direction beginning at 8 p.m., with up to three lanes closed in each direction, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night. A fourth lane may be closed overnight in each direction, as needed, for traffic shifts and bridge construction operations.
- **I-95 Ramp Impacts:** The I-95 entrance and exit ramps at Boynton Beach Boulevard may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night. One lane of the ramp will remain open during this time.
- **Full I-95 Ramp Closures:** The I-95 ramps at Boynton Beach Boulevard may close completely, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night. Please note only one I-95 ramp at the Boynton Beach Boulevard interchange is permitted to close at a time. Please follow the marked detour routes and proceed with caution.
- **Boynton Beach Boulevard Traffic Impacts:** Boynton Beach Boulevard may have one lane closed in each direction, with the westbound turn lane to the I-95 southbound entrance ramp closed as needed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Thursday night.
