S.R. A1A, EMERALD BEACH WAY TO S.R. 704/ROYAL PALM WAY — FALL 2025 UPDATE

Thursday, Nov. 13, 2025 marks day 171 of 482, with work 35% completed. Work remains focused on the final paving, striping and sidewalk operations on the south end of the project limits. Additional information, progress photos and videos can be found on the [project page](#).

Winter 2025-26 Seasonal Work Suspension: Major work activities and lane closures are expected to conclude by the Thanksgiving 2025 Holiday and resume in Spring 2026 in the vicinity of the Midtown Business District.

FINAL PAVING OPERATIONS FROM EMERALD BEACH WAY TO HAMMON AVENUE

- Final paving operations are ongoing through late November 2025 on S.R. A1A/S. Ocean Boulevard from just north of Emerald Beach Way to S. County Road, and from S. County Road to south of Hammon Avenue/Golfview Road
- A flagging operation may be in place, 8 a.m. until 6 a.m., and 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night through Friday
- Saturday daytime operations can be expected as needed through late November 2025

NORTHBOUND LANE CLOSURE ON S.R. A1A/S. COUNTY FOR SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT

- The northbound lane and sidewalk on S.R. A1A/S. County Road from Banyan Road to Hammon Avenue/Golfview Road is closed through late November 2025 for sidewalk construction; side streets will remain open
- Please follow directional signage and marked detour routes through the work zone and allow for extra travel time

NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN AT THE S.R. 80/SOUTHERN BOULEVARD TRAFFIC CIRCLE

- New asphalt and striping has been placed at the traffic circle as noted below
- Vehicles approaching the traffic circle are directed to yield, vehicles within the traffic circle have the Right-of-Way
