NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN AT THE S.R. A1A AND S.R. 80 TRAFFIC CIRCLE BY MAR-A-LAGO

New asphalt has been paved on S.R. A1A/S. Ocean Boulevard from just north of Emerald Beach Way to S. County Road, which includes the traffic circle at the intersection of S.R. 80/Southern Boulevard.

The new asphalt has been striped to facilitate traffic, as depicted below:

- Vehicles approaching the traffic circle are directed to yield
- Vehicles within the traffic circle have the Right-of-Way at all times
