FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. – Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of September 4, 2026, through September 11, 2026. CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

INTERSTATES

1. SW 10th Street Connector Project from S.R. 869/Sawgrass Expressway to S.R. 9/I-95 and on S.R. 9/I-95 from north of S.R. 834/Sample Road to north of S.R. 810/Hillsboro Boulevard in the City of Deerfield Beach.

Description: [The SW 10th Street Connector Project](#) is a major transportation improvement initiative that will enhance safety, improve traffic flow, and strengthen regional and local connectivity in the South Florida region. The project will create two separate roadway systems for regional and local travel by constructing dedicated SW 10th Street Connector lanes between the S.R. 869/Sawgrass Expressway and S.R. 9/I-95 while reconstructing local SW 10th Street with a 12-foot shared-use path for pedestrians and cyclists. Additional improvements include reconstruction of the S.R. 9/I-95 interchanges at SW 10th Street and S.R. 810/Hillsboro Boulevard, expansion of the I-95 Express Lanes, replacement of the NW/NE 48th Street bridge, and corridor-wide roadway, drainage, and safety enhancements. Together, these improvements will improve travel, reduce congestion, and support long-term regional transportation needs. Full Closure Traffic Impacts:

- In observance of the Labor Day holiday, work activities will be suspended Saturday, September 5 through Monday, September 7, 2026.
- **NW/NE 48th Street Bridge Full Closure Notice:** The NW/NE 48th Street Bridge over State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 closed on Sunday, August 2, in both directions for

full reconstruction, and will remain closed through **Summer 2027** as part of the **Early Construction Works** phase of the **SW 10th Street Connector Project**. To help ensure the safety of motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists, signed detour routes will be in place throughout the duration of the closure.

- **Regional traffic** will be directed to the primary state roadway network, including **SW 10th Street, S.R. 845/Powerline Road, S.R. 811/Dixie Highway, and S.R. 834/Sample Road**.
- **Local traffic** will be directed to alternate north-south routes, including **Military Trail** and **NE 3rd Avenue/FAU Research Park Boulevard**.
- Advance warning signs and detour signage will be installed throughout the construction limits to help guide travelers safely through the area. **Access to homes, businesses, schools, and emergency services** will be maintained at all times during construction.
- **Express Lanes Full Closure Notice:** The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes between S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard and S.R. 834/Sample Road will be closed to traffic nightly from 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Tuesday, September 8, through Thursday, Oct. 1, for bridge construction operations. Motorists will be directed to exit the Express Lanes onto the General-Purpose Lanes at S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard and may re-enter the Express Lanes north of S.R. 810/Hillsboro Boulevard.
- **Express Lanes Full Closure Notice:** The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes between S.R. 810/Hillsboro Boulevard and S.R. 814/Atlantic Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly from 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday beginning Tuesday, September 8, through Thursday, Oct. 1, for bridge construction operations. Motorists will be directed to exit the Express Lanes onto the General-Purpose Lanes at S.R. 810/Hillsboro Boulevard and may re-enter the Express Lanes by S.R. 814/Atlantic Boulevard.

S.R. 9/I-95 Lane Closures:

- Northbound S.R. 9/I-95 will have the two outside general-purpose lanes closed, between north of S.R. 834/Sample Road and SW 10th Street, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Tuesday, September 8, through Thursday, Oct. 1, for bridge construction operations.
- Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 will have the two outside general-purpose lanes closed, between north of SW 10th Street and S.R. 834/Sample Road, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, beginning Tuesday, September 8, through Thursday, Oct. 1, for bridge construction operations.

SW 10th Street & Arterial Traffic Impacts:

- Westbound SW 10th Street between S.R. 845/S Powerline Road and SW 30th Avenue will have up to two lanes closed overnight, from 8:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. on Monday, September 14 and Tuesday, September 15 for geotechnical boring operations. The first lane will close at 8:30 p.m. and the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., reopening by 5:30 a.m.
- Westbound SW 10th Street at S.R. 845/S Powerline Road will have up to two left turn lanes closed overnight, from 8:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 16 and Thursday, September 17 for geotechnical boring operations.

- Eastbound SW 10th Street at S.R. 845/S Powerline Road will have up to two left turn lanes closed overnight, from 8:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. on Wednesday, September 16 and Thursday, September 17 for geotechnical boring operations.

2. State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard in the City of Hollywood to the south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale and S.R. 862/I-595 from S.R. 9/I-95 to U.S. 441/S.R. 7 in the Town of Davie (95 Express Phase 3C)

Description: Work on this 9-mile 95 Express project includes extending the existing Express Lanes north from just south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to just south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Managed Lanes in each direction. The number of general-use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include the construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between S.R. 9/95 Managed Lanes and S.R. 862/I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95 and along S.R. 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along S.R. 9/I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, S.R. 9/I-95/S.R. 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, including cameras, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges, lighting, signage and drainage installation and construction of shoulder-mounted sound walls and retaining walls. S.R. 9/I-95 / S.R. 862/I-595 Full Mainline and Managed Lanes Upcoming Closures:

- **In observance of the Labor Day holiday, work activities will be suspended Saturday, September 5 through Monday, September 7, 2026.**
- **Northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes Full Closure:** The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes, from S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, and the inside general-purpose lane will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, as needed, beginning Tuesday, September 8 for maintenance and punch list operations. The ingress north of S.R. 848/Stirling Road will also be closed. Motorists must egress north of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard. The next available ingress is north of S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- **Northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes Full Closure:** The northbound Express Lanes, from County Road (C.R.) 854/Ives Dairy Road to S.R. 822/Sheridan Street, and the inside general-purpose lane will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, as needed, beginning Tuesday, September 8 for punch list operations and delineator maintenance. The Express Lanes entrance at S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will also be closed. Motorists traveling within the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at C.R. 854/Ives Dairy

Road onto the General-Purpose Lanes. The next available entrance will be north of S.R. 822/Sheridan Street. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- **Southbound Express Lanes Full Closure:** The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes from S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard to S.R. 848/Stirling Road, and the inside general-purpose lane will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, as needed beginning Tuesday, September 8 for punch list operations. The Express Lanes entrance at S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard and the Broward Boulevard Park and Ride will also be closed. Motorists traveling within the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will exit at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard onto the General-Purpose Lanes. The next available entrance will be at S.R. 822/Sheridan Street. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- **Southbound Managed Lanes Full Closure:** The southbound Express Lanes, from S.R. 822/Sheridan Street to C.R. 854/Ives Dairy Road, and the inside general-purpose lane will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, as needed, beginning Tuesday, September 8 for punch list operations. The Express Lanes entrance at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard will also be closed. Motorists traveling within the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at S.R. 822/Sheridan Street onto the General-Purpose Lanes. The next available entrance will be at C.R. 854/Ives Dairy Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- **Northbound and Southbound Managed Lanes Direct Connector Closures:** The eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 inside lane and the northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 direct connectors to the Express Lanes will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, as needed, beginning Tuesday, September 8 for punch list operations. Motorists will be required to use the general-purpose ramps to access northbound or southbound S.R. 9/I-95. FHP will be on-site, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- **Advanced Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Full Closure Notice:** All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 between S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 736/Davie Boulevard will be closed to traffic overnight from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, September 13, Tuesday, September 15, and Thursday, September 17 for loop repair operations. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 exit ramp to westbound S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard, southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7, and eastbound S.R. 736/Davie Boulevard to access the southbound S.R. 9/I-95. To ensure community and public safety, motorists travelling within the Managed Lanes will egress at S.R. 820/Oakland Park Boulevard. The ingress to southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed; Motorists may enter the Managed Lanes at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Sunday, September 20 will be used as a contingency night if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists. S.R. 9/I-95 Ramp and Traffic Impacts:

- The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from westbound S.R. 862/I-595 will be closed to traffic overnight on Monday, September 14 and Wednesday,

September 16, from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., for loop repair operations. Motorists will be detoured via southbound S.R. 9/I-95 and eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road to access northbound S.R. 9/I-95. Sunday, September 20 and Monday, September 21 will be used as contingency nights if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 will be closed to traffic overnight on Monday, September 14 and Wednesday, September 16, from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., for loop repair operations. Motorists will be detoured via northbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 and westbound S.R. 84/Marina Mile Boulevard to access northbound S.R. 9/I-95. Sunday, September 20 and Monday, September 21 will be used as contingency nights if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- S.R. 9/I-95 in each direction, between S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard and S.R. 736/Davie Boulevard, may have up to four lanes closed, nightly as needed, from 8:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving and vehicle detection loop installation. The first lane will close at 8:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 9 p.m., and the third and fourth lanes will close at 10 p.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- S.R. 9/I-95 in each direction, from S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 736/Davie Boulevard, will have shoulder closures, daily and nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday.
- The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from westbound S.R. 862/I-595 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from westbound S.R. 862/I-595 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 exit ramps to S.R. 818/Griffin Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 exit ramps to S.R. 848/Stirling Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed, from Sunday through Thursday.
- The northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramps from S.R. 848/Stirling Road may have one lane closed intermittently, nightly as needed, from 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, for ITS and drilled shaft operations.
- ***Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

S.R. 862/I-595 Ramp Full Closures and Traffic Impacts:

- S.R. 862/I-595 in each direction, from east of U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to Anglers Avenue, may have up to four lanes closed nightly as needed, from 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third and fourth lane will close at 10:30 p.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- S.R. 862/I-595 in each direction, from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95, will have shoulder closures, daily and nightly as needed, Sunday through Thursday.
- The eastbound and westbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from southbound S.R. 9/I-95 may have two lanes closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The westbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from southbound S.R. 9/I-95 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from northbound S.R. 9/I-95 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The westbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp from northbound S.R. 9/I-95 may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The westbound S.R. 862/I-595 westbound exit ramp to U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and the S.R. 91/Florida's Turnpike will have one lane closed nightly as needed, from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- ***Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

Arterial Traffic Impact:

- SW 26th Terrace may have flagging operations as needed.
- S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard at S.R. 9/I-95 may have the shoulder closed in each direction daily as needed for directional bore operations.
- S.R. 818/Griffin Road, from Old Griffin Road and Anglers Avenue, may have up to two lanes closed in each direction nightly, 8:30 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.

3. State Road (S.R.) 838/Sunrise Boulevard at S.R. 9/I-95 Interchange Improvements and Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project in Fort Lauderdale

Description: The project improvements include widening S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard at the S.R. 9/I-95 Interchange overpass to accommodate dual right turn lanes onto northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 to improve vehicular capacity and operations; widening the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 (Exit 29) off-ramp to accommodate triple left and triple right turn lanes onto S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard to improve vehicular capacity and operations; milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience; installing new light poles with LED fixtures at the S.R. 9/I-95 Interchange to enhance nighttime visibility; installing Wrong-Way Driver detection systems on all ramps at the S.R. 9/I-95 Interchange to improve vehicular safety; upgrading existing signalization features to improve pushbutton accessibility and

enhance pedestrian safety; adding a shared-use path on the S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard bridge over S.R. 9/I-95 to enhance pedestrian connectivity; and upgrading sidewalk curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to enhance visibility and accessibility. S.R. 9/I-95 Traffic Impacts:

- **In observance of the Labor Day holiday, work activities will be suspended Saturday, September 5 through Monday, September 7, 2026.**
- A temporary traffic shift on S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard has reduced the express lanes from two lanes to one lane in both directions to facilitate critical bridge construction. This configuration is expected to remain in place through Summer 2026 for ongoing improvements.
- S.R. 9/I-95 in each direction, between S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, may have up to two lanes closed, nightly as needed, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- **Full Closure Notice:** All lanes of northbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard (Exit 29B) will be closed to traffic Tuesday, September 8, from 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. This closure is necessary for crews to perform the placement of beams.
 - During the full closure, northbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the S.R. 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, northbound S.R. 845/Powerline Road, and westbound S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard. Motorists travelling within the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to follow the detour. FHP will be on site and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
 - Wednesday, September 9, will be used as a contingency night if needed.
- **Advanced Full Closure Notice:** All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed to traffic Wednesday night, September 9, 2026, Monday night, September 14, 2026, Wednesday night, September 16, 2026, Monday, September 21, and Tuesday, September 22, 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. This closure is necessary for crews to perform the placement of beams.
 - During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, westbound S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, southbound NW 31st Avenue/Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, eastbound S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, and then the S.R. 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Express lane traffic will exit just south of Atlantic Boulevard into the general-purpose lanes.
 - In association with this closure, the southbound express lane ingress at north of S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard will be closed. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard Impacts:

- S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard from just west of S.R. 9/I-95 to S.R. 5/U.S. 1/North Federal Highway may have up to two lanes intermittently closed, one direction at a time, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 7 a.m., Monday through Friday.

4. State Road (S.R.) 84/I-595 Corridor Resurfacing Project

Description: The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin the I-595 Corridor Resurfacing Project in mid-June 2025. This major infrastructure effort includes repaving and restriping I-595 and State Road 84 from I-75 to I-95, covering the Express Lanes, General Purpose Lanes, and adjacent segments of State Road 84. The project is designed to extend the service life of the pavement and improve safety for all roadway users. Construction will be performed in phases to minimize disruptions and will occur at night to reduce impacts to daytime traffic. Access to properties along the corridor will be maintained throughout the duration of the work. FDOT remains committed to working closely with the community to ensure transportation improvements reflect local needs and long-term goals. - Eastbound I-595 between west end of the project and Southwest 136th Avenue will have a lane closure from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights beginning Sunday, August 30, 2026, through Thursday, September 10, 2026, with a backup date of Sunday, September 13, 2026. Nightly milling, resurfacing, and striping activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
- Eastbound I-595 between west of the Sawgrass Expressway southbound lanes and Southwest 136th Avenue will have a lane closure from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights beginning Thursday, September 3, 2026, through Thursday, September 10, 2026 with a backup date of Sunday, September 13, 2026. Nightly milling, resurfacing, and striping activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
- Westbound I-595 between Southwest 136th Avenue and the west end of the project will have the left lane of the E-N Connector closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights from Thursday, September 3, 2026, through Thursday, September 10, 2026 with a backup date of Sunday, September 13, 2026. Nightly milling and resurfacing activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
- Westbound I-595 between Southwest 136th Avenue and the E-S Connector (Westbound I-595/Southbound I-75) will have the right lane of the E-S Connector closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights from Thursday, September 3, 2026, through Thursday, September 10, 2026 with a backup date of Sunday, September 13, 2026. Nightly milling and resurfacing activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
- Westbound I-595 between Southwest 136th Avenue and the E-S Connector (Westbound I-595 to Southbound I-75) will see the left lane on the E-S Connector and Ramp R1 closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights beginning Tuesday, September 8, 2026 to Thursday, September 10, 2026. Nightly milling, resurfacing, and striping activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
- Exit ramp from inside the Westbound Express lanes to the E-S Connector

(Westbound I-595/Southbound I-75) will have a lane closure from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on select nights beginning Sunday, September 6, 2026, through Thursday, September 10, 2026, with a backup date of Sunday, September 13, 2026. Nightly milling, resurfacing, and striping activities may be impacted by weather conditions.
