95 Express Lanes Phase 3C – Full Closure Notice

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

EASTBOUND S.R. 862/I-595 BETWEEN U.S. 441/S.R. 7 AND S.R. 9/I-95 TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT ON APRIL 27

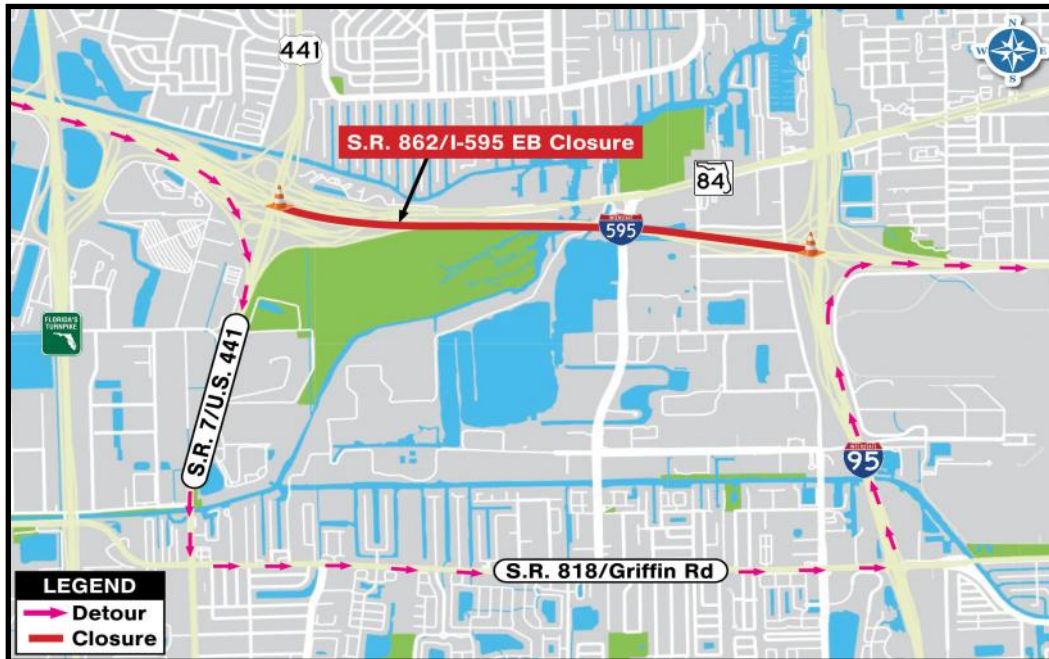
All lanes of eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 between U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and S.R. 9/I-95 will be closed to traffic from 10 p.m. until 4 a.m. on Monday, April 27. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install vehicle detection loops. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 10 p.m., reopening by 4 a.m. During the full closure, eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 traffic will be detoured via the eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp to southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7, eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road, and northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to access S.R. 862/I-595. Motorists destined for the Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport will follow the posted detour via southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and eastbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road to access Perimeter Road.

To ensure community and public safety, the following ramps will also be closed:

- Northbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp
- Southbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and S.R. 91/Florida's Turnpike to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp
- Davie Road to eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp
- S.R. 91/Florida's Turnpike to S.R. 862/I-595 and S.R. 84 ramp

Tuesday, April 28 will be used as a contingency night if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
