95 Express Lanes Phase 3C – Full Closure Notice

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

WESTBOUND S.R. 862/I-595 BETWEEN U.S. 441/S.R. 7 AND S.R. 9/I-95 TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT ON APRIL 19

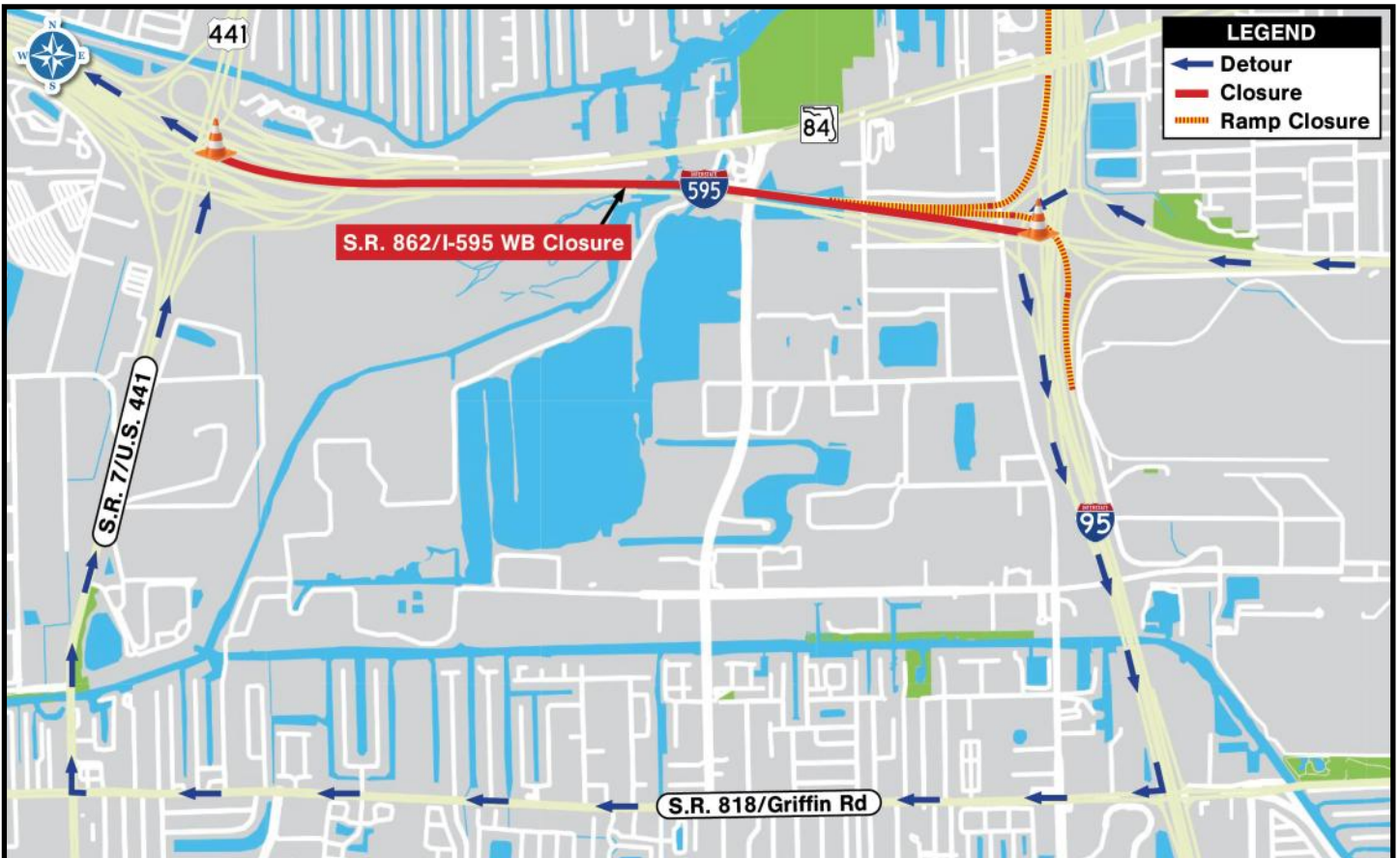
All lanes of westbound S.R. 862/I-595 between S.R. 9/I-95 and U.S. 441/S.R. 7 will be closed to traffic from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, April 19. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install vehicle detection loops. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During the full closure, westbound S.R. 862/I-595 traffic will be detoured via the westbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp to southbound S.R. 9/I-95, westbound S.R. 818/Griffin Road, and northbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to access the westbound S.R. 862/I-595 entrance ramp. In addition, the northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be closed from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m.; motorists traveling within the northbound Managed Lanes will exit at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard, with the next available entrance located at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard, and motorists traveling within the southbound Managed Lanes will exit at S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard, with the next available Managed Lanes entrance located at S.R. 848/Stirling Road.

To ensure community and public safety, the following ramps will also be closed from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m.:

- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 to westbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp
- The northbound S.R. 9/I-95 to westbound S.R. 862/I-595 ramp
- Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes entrance ramp from Broward Boulevard Park and Ride

Monday, April 20 and Tuesday, April 21 will be used as contingency nights if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
