
95 Express Lanes Phase 3C – Full Closure Notice

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

NB S.R. 9/I-95 BETWEEN S.R. 858/HALLANDALE BEACH BLVD AND S.R. 824/PEMBROKE RD TO CLOSE MARCH 29

All lanes of northbound S.R. 9/I-95 between S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard and S.R. 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic overnight from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 29. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install detection loops. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During the full closure, northbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard. Westbound S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard traffic will be detoured via northbound U.S. 441/S.R. 7 and eastbound S.R. 824/Pembroke Road to access northbound S.R. 9/I-95. Eastbound S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard traffic will be detoured via northbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5 and eastbound S.R. 824/Pembroke Road to access northbound S.R. 9/I-95. To ensure community and public safety, the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will also be closed. Motorists travelling within the northbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes at will exit at County Road (C.R.) 854/Ives Dairy Road to follow the detour. The entrance to the northbound Express Lanes at S.R. 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will be closed; the next available entrance is at S.R. 822/Sheridan Street. Monday, March 30 will be used as a contingency night if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
