95 Express Lanes Phase 3C – Full Closure Notice

State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard and S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95

SOUTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 BETWEEN S.R. 848/STIRLING RD AND S.R. 822/SHERIDAN ST TO CLOSE MARCH 22


All lanes of southbound S.R. 9/I-95 between S.R. 848/Stirling Road and S.R. 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic overnight from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 22. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install detection loops. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During the full closure, southbound S.R. 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to S.R. 848/Stirling Road. Westbound S.R. 848/Stirling Road traffic will be detoured via N 29th Avenue, and eastbound S.R. 822/Sheridan Street to access southbound S.R. 9/I-95. Eastbound S.R. 848/Stirling Road traffic will be detoured via southbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5, westbound S.R. 822/Sheridan Street to access southbound S.R. 9/I-95. To ensure community and public safety, the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 entrance ramp from S.R. 848/Stirling Road will also be closed from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m.

Motorists travelling within the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes will exit at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard to follow the detour. Motorists will be able to re-enter the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes at S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard. As a part of this closure, the following Express Lane entrances will also be closed from 11 a.m. until 5 a.m.:

- Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes entrance located at S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard
- Direct-Connector Flyover Ramps from eastbound S.R. 862/I-595 to northbound and southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Express Lanes

Monday, March 23 will be used as a contingency night if needed. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be onsite, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
