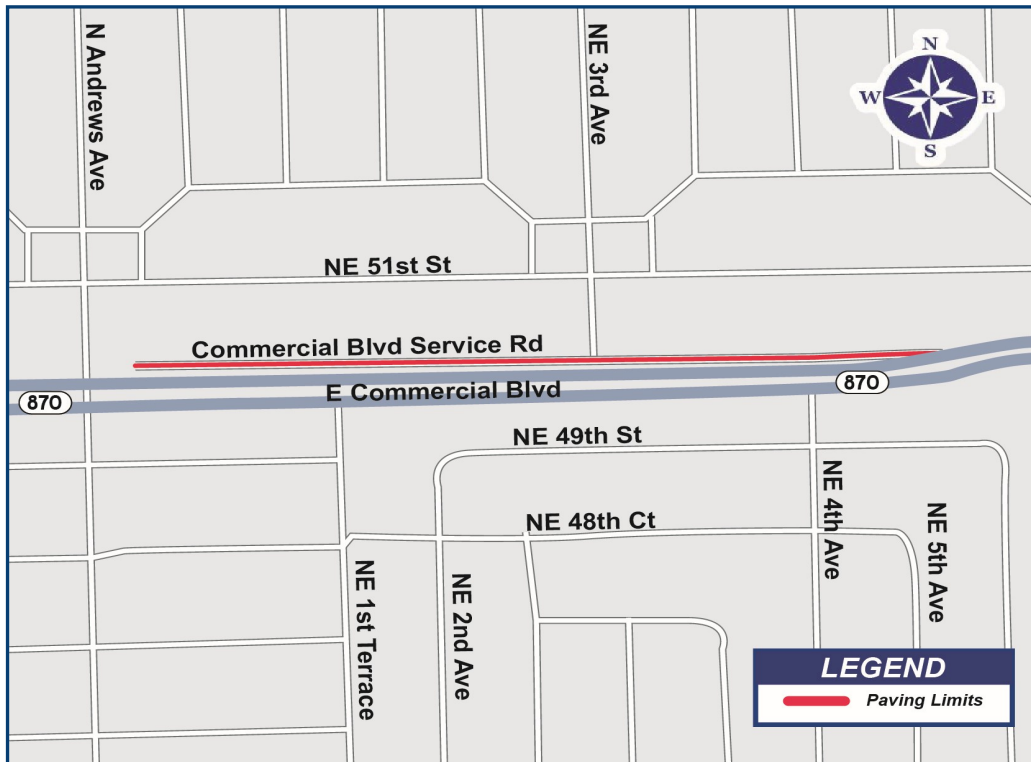

PAVING OPERATIONS TO BEGIN ON COMMERCIAL BLVD SERVICE ROAD AUGUST 24 THROUGH AUGUST 28

As part of the State Road (S.R.) 870/Commercial Boulevard, Resurfacing, Restoration, Rehabilitation (RRR), and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Improvements Project, the westbound S.R. 870/Commercial Boulevard service road will be closed intermittently overnight from Monday, August 24 through Friday, August 28, between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. to accommodate paving operations. Only a portion of the service road will be affected at a time, and traffic will be maintained through the work zone. Access to adjacent properties, businesses, and intersections, including NE 3rd Avenue, will be maintained throughout the operation.



To help ensure the work is completed safely and efficiently, we kindly ask that all vehicles parked along the service road within the designated work zone and paving limits be moved before paving operations begin. **Motorists should not leave vehicles unattended within the work zone during construction activities.**
