### ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR MARCH 2026—JUNE 2026

#### ROADWAY OPERATIONS

- Traffic shift to the east side of the Earman River Bridge to commence March 16, 2026.

#### EARMAN RIVER BRIDGE OPERATIONS

- Demolition of existing southbound bridge.
- Channel excavation of west side of the Earman River Canal.
- Driving of new southbound bridge piles.

#### UPCOMING MILESTONES

- Reconstruction of west side of the bridge, sidewalk, and curb and gutter.
- Traffic railing installation on west face side of the Earman River Bridge.

#### ACCOMPLISHED MILESTONES

- Completed construction of the east side of the new bridge.
- Northbound roadway widening and drainage installation completed.
