ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR JUNE 2026—SEPTEMBER 2026

ROADWAY OPERATIONS

- Reconstruction of the west sidewalk.
- Widening operations along southbound U.S. 1/S.R. 5.
- Installing drainage to support roadway improvements.

EARMAN RIVER BRIDGE OPERATIONS

- Installation of rip-rap along the shorelines of the west side of the Earman River Canal.
- Forming and pouring concrete for bridge pile caps.
- Installing bridge beams.

UPCOMING MILESTONES

- Reconstruction of west side of the bridge, including sidewalk, curb, and gutter.
- Shifting traffic onto the newly constructed southbound bridge.

ACCOMPLISHED MILESTONES

- Completion of excavation of the west side of the river beneath the new bridge.
- Completion of installation of piles for the southbound bridge.
