

TRAFFIC SHIFT ON NORTHBOUND U.S. 1/S.R. 5 EARMAN RIVER BRIDGE SCHEDULED FROM MARCH 16, 2026, TO SPRING 2027

To ensure public safety, emergency and first responder access will be coordinated and maintained at all times during construction. Signage will be placed in the area to direct and alert all roadway users.

CONSTRUCTING THE WESTERN PART OF THE NEW BRIDGE

- Starting at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, March 16, all motorists traveling on U.S. 1 /S.R. 5, from just south of Anchorage Drive to Northlake Boulevard, will be shifted to the newly constructed northbound bridge to safely facilitate the construction of the new southbound portion of the bridge.
- Two travel lanes will be open in each direction on the newly constructed portion of the bridge.
- Pedestrian detours and signage will guide pedestrians to the sidewalk located on the east side of the bridge.
- Access to all residences and businesses on the west side of U.S. 1/S.R. 5 will remain open.
